Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL intend to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

The Order will Amend the Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2010 by (a) specifying a maximum of 20 minutes waiting time for vehicles to load and unload on

- existing parking restrictions;
- (b) replacing the existing double yellow lines near the school in Lees Court Road, Sheldwich with School Keep Clear Markings on both sides of the road to improve pedestrian safety;
- (c) extending the existing and/or installing new double yellow lines on the junctions of Castlemere Avenue/Main Road and Edward Road/Castlemere Avenue in Queenborough,
- near Church Road Business Centre in Church Road, Murston, and in the service road to the east of Homebase, off Eurolink Way in Sittingbourne, to improve vehicle movement; (d) establishing a new disabled persons' parking bay in Rose Street (76), Sheerness, and removing the existing disabled persons' parking bays in Cowper Road (10), Middletune

Avenue (7), Murston Road (45-49) and Wellwinch Road (6) in Sittingbourne.
