## PROW - IN THE BOROUGH OF DARTFORD

#### CYCLE TRACKS ACT 1984

#### DARTFORD – CONVERSION OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS DB1 (PART) DARTFORD, DR1 (PART) STONE AND DR4 STONE CYCLE TRACKS ORDER 2014

In connection with the conversion of public footpaths DB1 (part), DR1 (part) and DR4 to Cycle Track, the Kent County Council made the above Order on 11th July 2014. If confirmed as made, the effect of the Cycle Tracks Order will be that those lengths of footpath to which the Order relates will become highway which, for the purpose of the Highways Act 1980, are highways maintainable at public expense and over which the public will have a right of way on pedal cycles (other than pedal cycles which are motor vehicles) and a right of way on foot.

The footpaths designated as cycle track by this Order are as follows:

DB1 (Part) & DR1 (Part) That width of the public footpaths from "The Tramway" cycle path at grid reference TQ5531 7716 (Point A on the Order Plan) to a connection at grid reference TQ5784 7530 (Point B on the Order Plan) for a distance of approximately 4,031 metres in a generally East South Easterly direction. A width of 3 metres is recorded.

DR4 That width of the public footpath from a connection with the Permissive Crossways Cycle Track at grid reference TQ 5790 7528 at grid reference TQ 5809 7504 (Point C on the Order Plan) to a connection with Crossways Boulevard (Point D on the Order Plan) for a distance of approximately 390 metres in a generally East South Easterly, thence Southerly direction. A width of 3 metres is recorded.

#### PUBLIC FOOTPATH DR1(PARTS)STONE PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2014

The above named Order made on the 11th July 2014 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert the entire width of (a) that length of public footpath numbered DR1 that commences from the unaffected part of public footpath DR1 at grid reference NGR TQ 5678 7610 (Point A on the Order Plan 1), and passes for approximately 211 metres in a generally East South Easterly, thence South Easterly direction, to a connection with the unaffected part of public footpath DR1 at grid reference NGR TQ 5696 7601 (Point B on the Order Plan 1); and (b) that length of public footpath numbered DR1 that commences from the unaffected part of public footpath DR1 at grid reference NGR TQ 5741 7562 (Point A on the Order Plan 2), and passes for approximately 137 metres in a generally South Easterly direction along the existing flood bund to a connection with the unaffected part of public footpath DR1 at grid reference NGR TQ 5751 7553 (Point B on the Order Plan 2)

A new length of public footpath will be added (a) numbered DR1 that commences from the unaffected part of public footpath DR1 at grid reference NGR TQ 5678 7610 (Point A on the Order Plan 1), and passes for approximately 205 metres in a generally East South Easterly direction along the existing flood bund to a connection with the unaffected part of public footpath DR1 at grid reference NGR TQ 5696 7601 (Point B on the Order Plan 1). The new length of path will have a width of 3 metres; and (b) numbered DR1 that commences from the unaffected part of public footpath DR1 at grid reference NGR TQ 5741 7562 (Point A on the Order Plan 2), and passes for approximately 143 metres in a generally South South Easterly, thence East South Easterly direction, underneath an existing ferry pontoon, to a connection with the unaffected part of public footpath DR1 at grid reference NGR TQ 5751 7553 (Point B on the Order Plan 2). The new length of path will have a width of 3 metres. All directions general, all distances approximate.

### NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

#### THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH ZR350 (PART) NEWNHAM) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2013

On 9th July 2014 the Kent County Council confirmed the above Order under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of that Order as confirmed is to divert the entire width of that length of public footpath ZR350 which commences on the unaffected length of public footpath ZR350 at NGR TQ 9442 5542 (Point A) and runs in an easterly direction for 107 metres to its connection with Frith Road (U1994) at NGR TQ 9452 5544 (Point B) and to provide a new length of public footpath ZR350 with a width of 2.0 metres which commences at the aforementioned Point A at NGR TQ 9442 5542 and runs in a northerly direction for 53 metres to NGR TQ 9442 5547 (Point C), thence east north easterly for 94 metres to a new connection with Frith Road (U1994) at NGR TQ 9451 5550 (Point D).

All directions are general, all distances are approximate.

- adding a bridleway numbered MR608, with a width of 4.0 metres, which commences on Bull Lane (C21) at NGR TQ 7249 5905 (point A) and runs west-north-west for 280 metres to its connection with MR609 at NGR TQ 7224 5915 (point B). Between the points A-B on the Order plan;
- upgrading to Bridleway status that length of public footpath MR465, which commences on MR608 at NGR TQ 7224 5915 (point B) and runs north-west through to north-north-west for 1310.0 metres to its connection with public footpath MR459 (part of which is to be upgraded and renumbered MR610) at NGR TQ 7167 6016 (point C). Between the points B-C on the Order plan. From point B the bridleway has a width of 4.0 metres for 273.0 metres until it reaches the floodgate at NGR TQ 7203 5933 after which it increases to 4.5 metres; after a further 190.0 metres the width decreases to 2.5 metres for its remaining length. There are two bollards on the route after 609.0 metres at NGR TQ 7184 5960 and at the northern end of the route after 1310.0 metres at the aforementioned point C. On upgrading the path will be renumbered MR609;
- upgrading to Bridleway status that part of public footpath MR459, which commences at NGR TQ 7167 6016 (point C) and runs east-north-east for 619.0 metres to its connection with MR30 at NGR TQ 7217 6047 (point D). Between the points C-D on the Order plan. From point C the bridleway has a width of 3.5 metres for 410.0 metres reducing to 2.5 metres for its remaining length. On upgrading the path will be renumbered MR610.

The above Order was made on 14th July 2014 under section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. If confirmed, it will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by upgrading to Bridleway status:

- that length of public footpath MR29, with a width of 2.5 metres, which commences on Court Road (U1460) at NGR TQ 7229 6187 (point A) and runs west-south-west for 455 metres, thence south-south-west for 365 metres (a total length of 820 metres) to its connection with U1459 at NGR TQ 7179 6130 (point B). (Between the points A-G-B on the Order plan);

- that length of public footpath MR454, which commences on Court Road (U1460) at NGR TQ 7287 6170 (point C) and runs south-west for 695 metres to NGR TQ 7243 6116 (point D), thence south-east for 488 metres to NGR TQ 7282 6089 (point E), (a total length of 1183 metres between the points C-H-D-E on the Order plan). The route has a width of 2.5 metres except at the footbridge at NGR TQ 7244 6118 where it narrows to 1.2 metres for a length of 13.5 metres. Upon upgrading, this path will be renumbered MR611.

If confirmed, the Order will also modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding:

- a bridleway numbered MR605, with a width of 2.5 metres, which commences at the junction of MR30 and Old Church Road (U1459) at NGR TQ 7182 6110 (point F) and runs east for 300.0 metres, thence north-east for 17.0 metres and thence east for 346.0 metres to its connection with MR611 (that part formerly numbered MR454) at NGR TQ 7243 6116 (point D). (Between the points F-D on the Order plan);

- a bridleway numbered MR606, with a width of 2.5 metres, which commences on MR29 at NGR TQ 7191 6164 (point G) and runs south-east for 710 metres to its connection with MR611 (that part formerly numbered MR454) at NGR TQ 7250 6125 (point H). (Between the points G-H on the Order plan);

- a bridleway numbered MR607, with a width of 5.5 metres, which commences on MR611 (that part formerly numbered MR454) at NGR TQ 7282 6089 (point E) and runs south-east for 200 metres to its connection with Bull Lane (C21) at NGR TQ 7296 6074 (point J). (Between the points E-J on the Order plan).

- That length of public footpath MR18A which commences on Rochester Road (C21) at NGR TQ 7235 6274 (point A) and runs north-north-east for 135 metres to its connection with MR18 at NGR TQ 7246 6282 (point B), thence north-east for 450 metres to another connection with MR18 at NGR TQ 7282 6292 (point C). Between the points A-B-C on the Order plan. From point A the path has a width of 2.0 metres for the first 7.0 metres and then 2.5 metres for its remaining length except where it narrows to 2.0 metres after 18.0 metres for a distance of 37.0 metres.

- That length of public footpath MR18 which commences on MR18A at the aforementioned point B and runs south-south-west for 40 metres, thence south-east for 180 metres, thence north-east for 341.0 metres to another connection with MR18A at the aforementioned point C, thence north-east for 297.0 metres to its connection with Common Road (U1469) at NGR TQ 7303 6313 (point D). Between the points B-C-D on the Order plan. From point B the path has a width of 2.5 metres except where it narrows to 2.0 metres after 27.5 metres for a distance of 15.0 metres and after 228.0 metres for a distance of 30.0 metres and again after 19.0 metres north-east of its north-easterly connection with MR18A for a distance of 29.0 metres.
