Kent County Council has made an Order the effect of which is to temporarily close Public Footpath TR34, between its junction with Newington Road and the footway to the rear of Chichester Road from the 25th August 2014.

The path will be closed for a maximum of six months, although it is expected that it will reopen earlier.

The path is closed because building demolition works are planned adjacent to it and there is a likelihood of danger to users. The path will also be moved to its correct legal alignment during the closure period and re-opened on that line.

There is an alternative route which will be signed for the duration of the closure.
