NOTICE OF THE INTENTION TO MAKE AN ORDER TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE PUBLIC FOOTPATH EE48B IN THE PARISH OF ASH PUBLIC FOOTPATH EE48B (PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Section 14(1), As Amended By The Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

Kent County Council intends to temporarily close Public Footpath EE48B, between its junction with Richborough Road and Goshall Railway crossing from the 15th September 2014.

The path will be closed for a maximum of six months.

The path is to be closed because works are planned near it and there is a likelihood of danger to users.

The alternative route is via Richborough Road.

NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF AN ORDER TEMPORARILY CLOSING PUBLIC FOOTPATH ER231

PUBLIC FOOTPATH ER231 (PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 Section 14(1), As Amended By The Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

The Secretary of State for Transport has directed that the Order made by Kent County Council on the 28th February 2014 and effective from the 3rd March 2014, the effect of which was to prohibit all traffic from Public Footpath ER231 has been extended for a further 6 months, until the 3rd March 2015.

The path is closed from its junction with Alkham Valley Road to point NGR TR2394 44028, a distance of approximately 50 metres.

An alternative route is signed on site and will remain so for the duration of the closure.

NOTICE OF THE INTENTION TO MAKE AN ORDER TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE PUBLIC FOOTPATH SR736 IN THE PARISH OF RIVERHEAD PUBLIC FOOTPATH SR736 (PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Section 14(1), As Amended By The Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

Kent County Council intends to temporarily close Public Footpath SR736, between its junction with Church Field and its junction with the A25 from the 8th September 2014.

The path will be closed for a maximum of six months, although it is expected that it will reopen before November 2014.

The path is to be closed because gas mains replacement works are planned and there is a likelihood of danger to users.

The alternative route is via Churchfield, Shoreham Lane and the A25 and will be signed for the duration of the closure.

NOTICE OF THE INTENTION TO MAKE AN ORDER TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY SR145

IN THE PARISH OF SEAL PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY SR145 (PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Section 14(1), As Amended By The Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

Kent County Council intends to temporarily close Public Bridleway SR145 for its entire length between its junction with Public Footpath SR146 and Rooks Hill from the 8th September 2014.

The path will be closed for a maximum of six months, although it is expected that it will reopen sooner.

The path is to be closed to enable the installation of rural broadband and there is a likelihood of danger to users.

There is no alternative route.

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

PUBLIC FOOTPATH (HM66 (PART) AND HM68 (PART) BRENZETT) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT

MODIFICATION ORDER 2014

On 14TH August 2014 the Kent County Council confirmed the above Order under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to (a) divert: the entire width of (1) that length of Public Footpath numbered HM66 commencing from Grid Reference TR 0138 3006 (Point A) and running in a southerly direction for 120 metres to its junction with Public Footpath HM67 to the north of St Augustine's Church at TR 0139 2995 (Point B). Between the points A and B on the Order Plan; and (2) that length of Public Footpath numbered HM68 commencing at Grid Reference TR 0159 3004 (Point D) and running for 40 metres in a south - south westerly direction to rejoin the unaffected length of Public Footpath HM68 at TR 0157 3001 (Point E). Between the points D and E on the Order Plan; and (b) to provide:

(1) a new length of Public Footpath numbered HM66 with a width of 2 metres Commencing from the aforementioned point A (TR 0138 3006) running in an east north easterly direction for 42 metres to TR 0142 3008 (Point C) then south - south easterly for 125 metres to its junction with Public Footpath HM67 at TR 0144 2996 (Point F). Between the points A, C and F on the Order Plan;

(2) a new length of Public Footpath HM68 with a width of 2 metres commencing at the afore mentioned point D (TR 0159 3004) and running in a south - south easterly direction for 20 metres and then in a west south westerly direction for 30 metres to rejoin the existing line of Public Footpath HM68 at TR 0157 3001 (Point E). Between the points D and E on the Order Plan.

All directions general, all distances approximate.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order Map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Offices of Shepway District Council, Castle Hill Avenue Folkestone CT20 2QY or at the Kent County Council, PROW & Access Service, Invicta House, Maidstone, Kent, ME14 1XX. Copies of the Order and Map may be purchased there at the price of £5.

The Order comes into force on 10th September 2014, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act which has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from the 22ND August 2014, make an application to the High Court.

NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF AN ORDER TEMPORARILY CLOSING PUBLIC FOOTPATH ZR505

PUBLIC FOOTPATH ZR505 (PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 Section 14(1), As Amended By The Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

The Secretary of State for Transport has directed that the Order made by Kent County Council on the 21st February 2014 and effective from the 24th February 2014, the effect of which was to prohibit all traffic from Public Footpath ZR505 has been extended for a further 5 years, until the 30th August 2019.

The path is closed from its junction with Public Footpath ZR497 and Public Footpath ZR504, a distance of approximately 580 metres.

The alternative route is via Public Footpath ZR497 to Head Hill Rd, north to Public Footpath ZR493 and then south along Public Footpath ZR504 and will be signed for the duration of the closure.

NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF AN ORDER TEMPORARILY CLOSING PUBLIC FOOTPATH MU30

PUBLIC FOOTPATH MU30 (PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) TEMPORARY ORDER 2013

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 Section 14(1), As Amended By The Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

The Secretary of State for Transport has directed that the Order made by Kent County Council on the 13th August 2013 and subsequently extended until the 2nd September 2014, the effect of which was to prohibit all traffic from Public Footpath MU30 has been extended for a further 6 months, until the 2nd March 2015.

The path is closed between The Gardens of Remembrance and River Lawn, a distance of approximately 50 metres.

There is an alternative route using pedestrian bridges to the sports ground.
