

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

WICKHURST ROAD, SEVENOAKS WEALD, SEVENOAKS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of an installation of BT Cables and ducts, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Wickhurst Road, Sevenoaks Weald, on or after 22nd October 2014 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from Wickhurst Road at the junction with Long Barn Road.

The alternative route is via Long Barn Road, Bowzell Road, Bayleys Hill, Wickhurst Road and vice versa.

VARIOUS ROADS, SEVENOAKS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014 THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994 SECTION 16A

Because of Sevenoaks Round Table Fireworks Festival and Torchlight Procession, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on Various Roads, Sevenoaks, on 8th November 2014 for up to 1 day as per Schedule 1.

Extent: from Pembroke Road to London Road - 16:30hrs -21:30hrs
Diversion: Pembroke Road, A224 London Road, A25 Westerham Road, A21 Southbound, A225 Riverhill/Tonbridge Road.

Extent: from South Park to High Street - 18:30hrs -21:30hrs
Diversion: A224 London Road, A25 Westerham Road, A21 Southbound, A225 Riverhill/Tonbridge Road.

Road Name: High Street/Tonbridge Road, Sevenoaks
Extent: from London Road, Tonbridge Road (south of Dukes Meadow Entrance to Sevenoaks School) - 18:30hrs -21:30hrs
Diversion: A225 Tonbridge Road/Riverhill, A21 London bound A225 Westerham Road, A224 London Road

Road Name: Rockdale Road, Sevenoaks
Extent: at the junction of High Street - 18:30hrs -21:30hrs
Diversion: n/a

Road Name: Oak Lane, Sevenoaks
Extent: at the junction of Tonbridge Road - 18:30hrs -21:30hrs
Diversion: n/a

Road Name: Solefields Road, Sevenoaks
Extent: at the junction of Tonbridge Road 18:30hrs - 21:30hrs
Diversion: n/a

SHEPWAY AREA

B2011 DOVER HILL, FOLKESTONE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of carriageway repairs, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on B2011 Dover Hill, Folkestone.

A closure is now planned to commence from 27 October 2014 for up to 5 days.

Dover Hill will be closed from the junction with Hill Road to where the road becomes New Dover Road, with no through access from Folkestone to Dover using this route.

The alternative route for through traffic is via A260 Hill Road, Canterbury Road, White Horse Hill, A20 Trunk Road, Courtwood Interchange, B2011 Folkestone Road, New Dover Road and Dover Hill.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

These works have been re-scheduled to be carried out during half term, when traffic levels are lower, and to reduce impact on school transport.

MELON LANE, IVYCHURCH (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of phone cabling works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Melon Lane, Ivychurch, Romney Marsh.

Melon Lane will be closed between Melon Farm and Golding Cottage, with no through access along Melon Lane.

Off-peak closures are planned to commence from 3 November 2014 for up to 2 days, between 09:30 hours and 15:30 hours each day.

The alternative route is via Ashford Road and Newchurch Lane.

SWALE AREA

ATLEE WAY & NORTH STREET, SITTINGBOURNE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of gas mains protection works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Attlee Way and North Street, Sittingbourne.

Closures are planned to commence from 20 October 2014 for an estimated period of up to 3 weeks for each road, starting with Attlee Way.

ATLEE WAY will be closed between the junctions with North Street and Satis Avenue.

The alternative route is via the remainder of Attlee Way, Grovehurst Road and North Street

NORTH STREET will be then be closed between the junctions with Attlee Way and Hinde Close

The alternative route is via Court Road, Regis Crescent, Langley Road, Saffron Way.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the roads outside the working hours.

CROWN ROAD, MILTON REGIS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of carriageway resurfacing works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Crown Road, Milton Regis, Sittingbourne.

Off-peak closures are planned to commence from Tuesday 21 October 2014 for up to 2 days between 09:30 hours and 15:30 hours each day.

Crown Road will be closed between the junctions with Staplehurst Road and High Street.

The alternative route is via B2006 St Paul's Street, B2005 Mill Way, Saffron Way, North Street and High Street.

(VARIOUS ROADS, BOROUGH OF SWALE) WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES (AMENDMENT 12) ORDER 2014

The Kent County Council, in exercise of their powers and under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 44, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby propose to make the following Order:-

The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Amendment 12) Order 2014 shall be amended as follows:

Roads in Sittingbourne in the Borough of Swale

No waiting at any time

The following items to be added to the First Schedule in the correct alphabetical sequence or in place of the existing entry:

Road Name: Chestnut Street
Distance: (1) On the north side

(a) from a point in line with the boundary of the 1 Florence Cottages and the Tudor Rose Public House, for a distance of 89 metres in an easterly direction;
(b) between points 107 metres and 125 metres east of the boundary of 1 Florence Cottages and the Tudor Rose Public House.

(2) On the south side, from a point in line with the boundary of 1 Florence Cottages and the Tudor Rose Public House, for a distance of 170 metres in an easterly direction.

Road Name: Maidstone Road, Danaway
Distance: On the southeast side

From a point 10 metres northeast of the north-eastern kerbline of Oak Close, Danaway, to a point 10 metres southwest of the south-western kerbline of Westfield Gardens.

Road Name: Dental Close
Distance: On both sides, from the western kerbline of Wisles Lane for a distance of 15 metres in a westerly direction.

Road Name: Hilton Drive

Distance: On the eastern side of the road, between points 10 metres and 25 metres south of the centre of the Clive Road junction.

Road Name: Manor Grove

Distance: (1) On the north-eastern/north-western side, from a point 5 metres southeast of the boundary of 93/95 Manor Grove, to a point 3 metres northeast of the northern building line of 4 Manor Grove

(2) On the south-western/western side, from a point 5 metres southeast of the boundary of 93/95 Manor Grove, to a point in line with the southern building line of 62 Manor Grove.

Road Name: Sheerstone, Iwade

Distance: (1) On the western side, from a point in line with the boundary of 8/10 Sheerstone, for a distance of 30 metres in a southerly direction.

(2) On the north and south side, from the western kerbline of Sheerstone for a distance of 25 metres in westerly direction.

Road Name: Langley Road

Distance: On the north-eastern side, between points 15 metres northeast and southwest of the centre of the Trinity Road junction.

Road Name: Trinity Road

Distance: On both sides, from the north-western kerbline of Langley Road for a distance of 15 metres in a north-westerly direction.

Road Name: West Ridge

Distance: On the southern side, between points 4.5 metres west and 5.5 metres east of the boundary of 9/11 West Ridge.

Wises Lane

(1) On the eastern side

(a) from the junction with London Road for a distance of 54 metres in a southerly direction;

(b) from the junction with Grove Park Avenue for a distance of 29 metres in a southerly direction;

(c) from a point 7 metres north of the northern kerbline of the northern junction with Brier Road to a point 7 metres south of the southern kerbline of the northern junction of Brier Road;

(d) from a point in line with the boundary of 65/67 Wises Lane to a point in line with the southern boundary of 71 Wises Lane.

(2) On the western side

(a) from the junction with London Road, southwards to a point in line with the boundary of 10/10a Wises Lane;
(b) between points 13 metres north and 13m south of the centre of the junction of Dental Close.

One Hour restricted waiting

The following item to be added to the Third Schedule in place of the existing entry:-

Roads in Sittingbourne

Name of Road: WISES LANE

Length of Road: (1) On the eastern side, from a point 7 metres north of the junction with the northern junction with Brier Road to a point 29 metres south of the junction with Grove Park Avenue.

Days on which restriction applies: Mon-Sat
Times at which restriction applies: 8.30am to 6.30pm

Length of Road: (2) On the western side of the road

Days on which restriction applies: Mon-Sat
Times at which restriction applies: 9.30 to 10.30am & 2.30 to 3.30pm

(a) from a point opposite the boundary of 17/19 Wises Lane south to a point 13 metres north of the centre of the junction of Dental Close;

(b) from a point 13 metres south of the centre of the junction of Dental Close south to a point in line with the rear boundary of 1 Dental Close.

Days on which restriction applies: Mon-Sat
Times at which restriction applies: 9.30 to 10.30am & 2.30 to 3.30pm.

TONBRIDGE & MALLING AREA

CASTLE WAY AND A228 ASHTON WAY, LEYBOURNE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of carriageway resurfacing works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on Castle Way and A228 Ashton Way, Leybourne, on or after 4 November 2014 for up to 13 nights between 21.00hrs and 05.00hrs or until the works have been completed.

Castle Way will be closed between A20 London Road and Pump Close. The alternative route is via A228 Leybourne By-Pass, round the roundabout and back onto Castle Way. A228 Ashton Way will be closed between A20 London Road and A228 Leybourne By-Pass. The alternative route is via Castle Way, round the roundabout back onto A228 Leybourne By-Pass. The alternative route for HGV traffic is via A20 London Road, M26, M20 and Castle Way.

A228 HOLBOROUGH ROAD, SNODLAND (CLOSURE OF LAY-BY) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because it is necessary to construct a site access to enable the construction of a rail and river bridge, Kent County Council has made an Order to close the southbound lay-by opposite The Lodge on A228 Holborough Road, Snodland, on or after 20 October 2014 for up to 18 months or until the works have been completed.

B245 LONDON ROAD, TONBRIDGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of carriageway resurfacing works, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on B245 London Road, Tonbridge, on or after 18 October 2014 from 19.00hrs to 12.00hrs 19 October 2014 or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Dry Hill Park Road and Dry Hill Road.

The alternative route is via A227 Shipbourne Road and Dry Hill Park Road.

TONBRIDGE WELLS AREA

WATER LANE, HAWKHURST (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because it is necessary to replace a BT Openreach cover and frame and build a concrete chamber to install poly duct in the carriageway, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Water Lane, Hawkhurst, on or after 20 October 2014 for up to 10 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from St Ronan's School to Keeper's Cottage.

The alternative route is via A229 Hawkhurst Road/ Cranbrook Road and A268 Rye Road.
