

## Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

### ASHFORD AREA

#### A28 ASHFORD ROAD, GREAT CHART (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of junction safety improvements, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A28 Ashford Road, Great Chart.

Overnight closures are planned to commence from Saturday 15 November 2014 for up to 3 nights, between 19:00 hours through until 05:00 hours each night.

A28 Ashford Road will be closed in the vicinity of the junction with Chilmington Green Road, with no direct access during closures.

The alternative route is via A28 Great Chart Bypass, Ashford Road, B2229 Brookfield Road, Beaver Lane, Beaver Road, Norman Road, Romney Marsh Road, Ashford Road, Maggie Hall Road, Tally Ho Road, Woodchurch Road, Bethersden Road and A28 Ashford Road.

Chilmington Green Road will be closed at the junction Ashford Road; access remains from the junction with Criol Lane / Maggie Hall Road, and through traffic should join the above diversion.

#### BLACKWALL ROAD NORTH, ASHFORD (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of works to install a broadband cabinet and associated cabling, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Blackwall Road North, Ashford.

A closure is planned to commence from 27 October 2014 for an estimated period of up to 5 days.

Blackwall Road North will be closed from the junction with Kennington Road to the vicinity of number 19.

The alternative route is via A2070 Kennington Road and Blackwall Road South.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

#### A28 CANTERBURY ROAD, BOUGHTON ALUPH & KENNINGTON (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of carriageway repairs, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A28 Canterbury Road, Boughton Aluph and Kennington.

Overnight closures are planned to commence from Monday 10 November 2014 for up to 2 nights, between 19:00 hours through until 05:00 hours each night.

A28 Canterbury Road will be closed between the junctions with Ball Lane and Wye Road / Harville Road, with no through access between Spearpoint Corner and Chilham using the A28.

~ There will be no direct access between Ashford and Canterbury during these works ~

The alternative route for through traffic is via A28 Canterbury Road, A2042 / A251 Faversham Road, Buck Street, A252 Canterbury Road, The Street, Maidstone Road, A28 Ashford Road, Canterbury Road and vice versa.

#### B2067 KNOLL HILL, ALDINGTON (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of works to install a new drainage system, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of B2067 Knoll Hill, Aldington.

A closure is planned to commence from 27 October 2014 for an estimated period of up to 2 weeks.

B2067 Knoll Hill will be closed in the vicinity of Strawberry Hill, with no access for through traffic between the junctions with Giggers Green Road and Roman Road.

The alternative route is via Knoll Hill, Boat Lane, New Road Hill, Forge Hill and Roman Road.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

#### A28 ROLVENDEN HILL, ROLVENDEN (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of carriageway repairs, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A28 Rolvenden Hill, Rolvenden, Tenterden.

Overnight closures are planned to commence from Monday 10 November 2014 for up to 5 nights, between 19:00 hours through until 05:00 hours each night.

A28 Rolvenden Hill will be closed between the junction with Mounts Lane and Rolvenden Level Crossing, with no direct access between Rolvenden and Tenterden.

The alternative route is via B2086 Regent Street, Benenden Road, Rolvenden Road, The Street, New Pond Road, Goddard's Green Road, Benenden Road, Tenterden Road, Cranbrook Road, A28 Rolvenden Hill and vice versa.

#### STATION ROAD, SMEETH (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of junction safety improvements, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Station Road, Smeth.

Off-peak closures are planned to commence from 10 November 2014 for up to 3 days, between 09:30 hours and 15:30 hours each day.

Station Road will be closed in the vicinity of the junction with the A20 Hythe Road.

The alternative route is via Bower Road, The Street (Mersham) and A20 Hythe Road.

#### A28 TEMPLAR WAY, ASHFORD (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of carriageway resurfacing works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit southbound traffic on part of A28 Templar Way, Ashford.

An overnight closure is planned for Wednesday 12 November 2014 for 1 night, from 21:00 hours through until 05:00 hours.

A28 Templar Way will be closed southbound only (i.e. away from Ashford), between the junctions with Repton Avenue (Waitrose) and Chart Road Roundabout.

The alternative route is via A292 Maidstone Road, New Street, Forge Lane, West Street, Elwick Road, Beaver Road, Victoria Road, Leacon Road, B2229 Brookfield Road and A28 Chart Road.

Northbound traffic (i.e. towards A20 / M20) is unaffected.

### CANTERBURY AREA

#### MAYPOLE ROAD, HOATH (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of essential carriageway repairs, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Maypole Road, Hoath.

A closure is planned to commence from 27 October 2014 for an estimated period of up to 5 days.

Maypole Road will be closed between the 2 junctions with Maypole Lane.

The alternative route is via Maypole Lane.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

#### NORTHGATE, CANTERBURY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of works to provide a new electricity supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Northgate, Canterbury.

A closure is planned to commence from 27 October 2014 for an estimated period of up to 3 days.

Northgate will be closed in the vicinity of the junction with St John's Place, with no through access between the junctions with Broad Street and High Street St Gregory's at any time.

The alternative routes are

Eastbound – via Broad Street, A28 Military Road, Tourtel Way and Northgate

Westbound – via Northgate, B2248 Kingsmead Road, St. Stephen's Road, The Causeway, Pound Lane, St. Radigund's Street, Knott's Lane, King Street and The Borough.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

#### (ST DUNSTAN'S STREET, THE DISTRICT OF CANTERBURY) (6' 6" WIDTH RESTRICTION) ORDER 2014

NOTICE is hereby given that The Kent County Council, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 9, 10(2) and 124 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, proposes to make the above named Order.

The general effect of this order is to implement a 6 feet 6 inch width limit which prevents any vehicle with a width exceeding 6' 6" to proceed in those lengths of road specified in the Schedule of the Order. Exemptions are provided in the Order for; emergency services, authorities in pursuance of statutory powers and local buses. Full details of the exemptions are provided in the articles of the Order. Roads effected by the Order are:-

Road Name	Parish	Description
ST DUNSTAN'S STREET	Canterbury	Between (but not including) its junctions with North Lane and Pound Lane on the north-eastern side of the carriageway only, through the Westgate Towers.

#### SOUTH BARHAM ROAD, BARHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2014

Because of carriageway patching works following earlier flooding, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on South Barham Road, Barham, Canterbury.

Closures are planned to commence from 27 October 2014 for an estimated period of up to 3 weeks or until the works have been completed.

South Barham Road, Barham will be closed in various phases for its entire length, with no through access.

The alternative route is via Derringstone Street, Derringstone Hill and South Barham Hill.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

Access will be maintained whenever it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be some delays and certain times when this is not possible, due to the nature of the works and the use of machinery.

#### VARIOUS ROADS, FORDWICH (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of carriageway patching works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Various Roads, Fordwich, Canterbury.

Daytime closures are planned to commence from 27 October 2014 for up to 5 days, between 08:00 hours and 16:00 hours each day.

Roads will be closed in sequence, as shown below. During these closures, there will be no direct access through Fordwich. Access will remain as far as where the roads are closed.

WELL LANE – closed from Monday 27 October for 2 days

FORDWICH ROAD – closed from Monday 27 October for 1 day

KING STREET – closed from Tuesday 28 October for 1 day

MOAT LANE – closed from Wednesday 29 October for 3 days

The alternative route for all through traffic is via Moat Lane, Stodmarsh Road, A257 Littlebourne Road, St Martin's Hill, Longport, Lower Chantry Lane, St George's Place, A28 Lower Bridge Street, Broad Street, Military Road, Tourtel Road, Sturry Road, Mill Road, Water Lane, Fordwich Road, King Street, High Street and Moat Lane.

#### (VARIOUS ROADS, THE DISTRICT OF CANTERBURY) (7.5 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2014

NOTICE is hereby given that The Kent County Council, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 9, 10(2) and 124 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, proposes to make the above named Order.

The general effect of this order is to implement a 7.5 Tonne weight limit which prevents any vehicle with a weight exceeding 7.5T to proceed in those lengths of road specified in the Schedule of the Order. Exemptions are provided in the Order for; emergency services, authorities in pursuance of statutory powers, buses and access. Full details of the exemptions are provided in the articles of the Order.
