

Highways

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

STADE STREET – between the junctions with West Parade and South Road,

SOUTH ROAD – for its entire length,

TWISS ROAD – between the junctions with South Road and Seabrook Road

The extent of restrictions will be indicated by No Waiting signage and No Waiting cones placed on site.

The restrictions will only be imposed where necessary for the safety of the public and workforce, and are to avoid the need for other traffic restrictions such as traffic lights.

The Order has the effect of suspending any existing parking entitlements and restrictions that apply to the sections of roads defined above.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to lift waiting restrictions outside the working hours.

SWALE AREA

RHODE COMMON ROAD, SELLING (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of bridge maintenance and repair works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Rhode Common Road, Selling, Faversham.

Closures are planned as follows

- Sunday 16 November 2014 from 02:00 hours through until Monday 17 November at 05:30 hours
- Tuesday 18 November for up to 4 nights, between 00:15 hours and 05:30 hours each night

Rhode Common Road will be closed in the vicinity of Gore Court Railway Bridge, with no through access.

The alternative route is via Selling Road, Crouch Lane (note 13' 6" height restriction), Kit Hill, South Street, and Scoggers Hill to Rhode Common Road.

TONBRIDGE & MALLING AREA

CHURCH ROAD, OFFHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of the construction of a new junction, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Church Road, Offham, on or after 27 October 2014 and 16 February 2015 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside St Michael's Church.

The alternative route is via A20 London Road and Teston Road.

CLARE LANE & MILL STREET, EAST MALLING (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because it is necessary to replace BT covers and frames, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Clare Lane & Mill Street, East Malling, on or after 27 October 2014 for up to 5 days between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs or until the works have been completed.

Clare Lane will be closed from Clarewood Drive to outside number 29 Clare Lane and Mill Street will be closed outside number 175.

The alternative route is via Mill Street, New Road, A20 London Road, Town Hill, High Street, Swan Street and Lucks Hill.

COURT ROAD, BURHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because it is necessary for gas mains diversion works and to construct a new carriageway, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Court Road, Burham, on or after 27 October 2014 for up to 14 months or until the works have been completed.

The road will be re-opened between 19th December 2014 and 5th January 2015 for the Christmas period.

The road will be closed between Bell Lane and Margetts Lane.

The alternative route is via Margetts Lane, Scarborough Lane and Rochester Road.

EGGPIE LANE, HILDENBOROUGH (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because it is necessary to connect a property to the mains sewer, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on Eggpie Lane, Hildenborough, on or after 10 November 2014 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside "Blenneville".

The alternative route is via Scabharbour Road and Philpots Lane.

B245 LONDON ROAD, TONBRIDGE (CYCLE LANE SUSPENSION) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

For the safety of the public and workforce during a new gas installation, Kent County Council has made an Order to suspend the cycle lane on B245 London Road, outside Tonbridge School, on or after 25 October 2014 for up to 2 days or until the works have been completed.

THE STREET, CHURCH HILL & PLAXTOL LANE, PLAXTOL (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of fibre optic broadband works, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on The Street, Church Hill and Plaxtol Lane, Plaxtol, on or after 25 October 2014 for up to 9 days or until the works have been completed.

The roads will be closed on separate occasions as indicated by signage.

The whole length of The Street and Church Hill will be closed and Plaxtol Lane from Tree Lane to outside The Retreat.

The alternative route for The Street is via School Lane, Hamptons Road, Dunk's Green Road and Long Mill Lane, for Church Hill is via Tree Lane, Grange Hill, Dux Hill, Long Mill Lane and The Street and for Plaxtol Lane is via A227 Tonbridge Road, Bewley Lane, Sheet Hill, Yopps Green and Tree Lane.

TUNBRIDGE WELLS AREA

LADHAM ROAD, GOUDHURST (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because it is necessary to install a new low voltage cable, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on Ladhams Road, Goudhurst, on or after 10 November 2014 for up to 10 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from Bakers Farm House to The Granary.

The alternative route is via Ladhams Road, B2084 Chequers Road and Jarvis Lane.

LITTLE MOUNT SION, TUNBRIDGE WELLS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because a new gas service is to be installed, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Little Mount Sion, Tunbridge Wells, on or after 27 October 2014 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 36.

The alternative route is via B2023 High Street/Mount Sion and Berkeley Road.

SOMERSET ROAD, TUNBRIDGE WELLS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because it is necessary for a crane to lift a classroom into Skinners School, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Somerset Road, on or after 27 October 2014 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from A26 St John's Road to Mereworth Road.

The alternative route is via A26 St John's Road, East Cliff Road and Mereworth Road.
