Highways

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

THANET AREA

HIGH STREET, GARLINGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) **TEMPORARY ORDER 2014**

To allow access to cabling to restore customer phone services, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of High Street, Garlinge, Margate.

An off-peak closure is planned to commence from 3 December 2014 between 09:30 hours and 15:30 hours.

High Street, Garlinge will be closed in the vicinity of Zeila Farm (to the north of the junction with Shottendane Road), with no through access.

Access will continue from either direction up to where the road is closed, with access to Garlinge from the A28 Canterbury Road direction.

The alternative route is via Shottendane Road, Minster Road and A28 Canterbury Road.

PARK PLACE, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) **TEMPORARY ORDER DECEMBER 2014**

Because of works to provide a gas supply to a new development, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Park Place, Margate.

A closure is planned to commence from 1 December 2014 for an estimated period of up to 3 days.

Park Place, Margate will be closed in the vicinity of properties 7-11, with no through access at any time.

The alternative route is via Grosvenor Gardens, Churchfields, High Street and Grosvenor Hill.

The Prohibition of Driving and One-way Traffic Orders in respect of High Street, Margate will be suspended, between the junctions with Mill Lane and Grosvenor Hill.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to lift these restrictions outside the working hours.

ST JOHN'S CRESCENT, RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF **DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014**

Because of works to provide a new sewer connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of St John's Crescent (The Centre), Ramsgate.

A closure is planned to commence from 1 December 2014 for an estimated period of up to 2 weeks.

St John's Crescent will be closed between the junctions with Wentworth Drive and Princess Margaret Avenue, with no through access at any time.

The alternative route is via Wentworth Drive, Rossland Road and Princess Margaret Avenue.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

WESTBROOK GARDENS, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

To allow safe site access for lorries during construction works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit waiting on part of Westbrook Gardens, Margate, on or after 1 December 2014.

Waiting will be prohibited on the eastern side of Westbrook Gardens, from the existing double vellow lines southwards to the northern boundary of property number 7

The restrictions apply all weekdays between 07:00 and 18:00 hours each day and all Saturdays between 07:00 and 13:00 hours each day.

The temporary waiting restrictions will be clearly indicated by No Waiting signs and a single vellow line on the road whilst they are in operation.

This has the effect of suspending any existing parking entitlements and restrictions that apply to the section of road defined above.

The restrictions come into effect from 1 December 2014 with estimated completion by 10 October 2015.
