(VARIOUS ROADS, BOROUGH OF ASHFORD) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No. 2) ORDER 2014

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL have made the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

The Order amends Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Ashford) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2014 as follows :

Disabled persons vehicle parking places

The Order authorises a parking place for a disabled persons vehicle in the following location -Ashford - Lockholt Close - in the lay-by on the south-western side between points 0.7 metres and 7.3 metres south-east of the south-eastern building line of 43-47 Lockholt Close

The Order was made on 17th December, 2014 and will come into effect on 22nd December, 2014.

Full details are contained in the made Order which, together with the relevant drawing, a copy of any orders amended by the made Order, and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be examined at Ashford Gateway Plus, Church Road, Ashford, Kent TN23 1AS. Information relating to the made Order will be available for inspection at the Main Reception, Sessions House, Maidstone ME14 1XQ, during normal office hours.

Any person wishing to question the validity of an Order or of any of its provisions on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that a requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Courts
