

Highways

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

THANET AREA

A299 MONKTON ROUNDABOUT, MONKTON (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2015

Because of carriageway resurfacing works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on A299 Monkton Roundabout, Monkton.

Overnight closures are planned from Monday 13 April 2015 for 2 nights, between 23:00 hours through until 05:00 hours each night.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via A28 Canterbury Road, B2052 George V Road, Hartsdown Road, Tivoli Road, Beatrice Road (B2052 College Road in opposite direction due to one-way system), A254 Ramsgate Road, Margate Road, A256 Haine Road, New Haine Road, Haine Road, A256 / A299 Hengist Way and Canterbury Road West

Thanet-bound traffic on A253 Ramsgate Road / Canterbury Road will be diverted via A28 Canterbury Road (Sarre) to join the above route.

Seamark Road can be accessed from its northern junction with A28 Canterbury Road.

WAY HILL & WAYBOROUGH HILL, MINSTER (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2015

Because of gas mains replacement works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Way Hill and Wayborough Hill, Minster, Thanet.

Closures are planned to commence from 7 April 2015 with estimated completion by 15 May 2015.

WAY HILL will be closed from the junction with Grinsell Hill to just beyond the junction with Wayborough Hill

The alternative route is via Grinsell Hill, Thorne Hill and Way Hill.

WAYBOROUGH HILL will be closed between Way Hill and Wayborough Bungalow at some stage as the works progress

There is no alternative route as the road is a cul-de-sac; every effort will be made to maintain access for residents and their visitors

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the roads outside the working hours.
