Notice of application for grant of a premises licence

Notice is hereby given that English Heritage Trust/Richborough Roman Fort and Amphitheatre has applied to Dover District Council for the grant of the premises licence for:

1) enable the sale of alcohol between 10:00 and 18:00 Monday to Sunday - April to October, 10:00 and 16:00 Saturday's and Sunday's - November to March
And - in the years when the Easter holidays fall in March, and/or the Autumn half term holiday falls in November, the site will remain open daily 10:00 - 18:00 for the duration of the school holiday and sell alcohol when open.

Any person wishing to submit relevant representations to this application must give notice in writing to the address shown above, giving in detail the grounds of objection by: Monday 15th June 2015. Dated: 16th May 2015

The Council will not entertain representations where the writer requests that his identity remains anonymous. Copies of all representations will be included in the papers presented to the Licensing Panel and will therefore pass into the public domain.

Representations must relate to one or more of the four Licensing Objectives: the Prevention of Crime and Disorder, Public Safety, the Prevention of Public Nuisance and the Protection of Children from Harm.

It is an offence liable on conviction to a fine up to Level 5 on the standard scale under Section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003 to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with this application.
