Highways

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

THANET AREA

A256 WESTWOOD ROAD, BROADSTAIRS (PROHIBITION **OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2015**

Because of carriageway patching works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A256 Westwood Road. Broadstairs.

Overnight closures are planned from Monday 7 September 2015 for up to 2 nights, between 19:00 hours through until 05:00 each night.

Westwood Road will be closed to through traffic between Pearce Signs Roundabout and the junction with Poorhole Lane.

The alternative route is via A254 Margate Road and Poorhole Lane.

LOMBARD STREET, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF **DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2015**

Because works to provide a gas supply to a property re-development, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Lombard Street, Margate.

A closure is planned to commence from Tuesday 8 September 2015 for an estimated period of up to 3 days.

Lombard Street will be closed in the vicinity of number 2 (next to The Wig & Pen) with no access between New Cross Street and Hawley Street.

The alternative route is via New Cross Street, New Street and Hawley Street

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of Lombard Street will be suspended between New Cross Street and Hawley Street during the closure, to allow access / exit up to the point of closure

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of New Cross Street will be suspended to allow its use for the diversion.

Waiting will be prohibited at all times on both sides of New Cross Street, where there are no existing restrictions, to the extent indicated by No Waiting Cones and signage on site.

This Order suspends any e-xisting parking entitlements and restrictions that apply to New Cross Street.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road or lift restrictions outside the working hours.

WESTGATE BAY AVENUE, WESTGATE-ON-SEA (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2015

Because of works to install a zebra crossing, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Westgate Bay Avenue, Westgate-on-Sea, Margate.

Closures are planned to commence on or after Monday 21 September 2015. There will be an initial 2-day closure at the start of the works, with a further one-day closure near the end (up to 2 weeks later).

Westgate Bay Avenue will be closed to the east of the junction with St Mildred's Road, with no through access.

The alternative route is via St Mildred's Road, Sea Road and Westgate Bay Avenue.

Due to the nature of these works, it is unlikely the road can be re-opened outside the working hours.

VARIOUS ROADS, PEGWELL & RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2015

Because of works to upgrade the local sewer system, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on various roads in Pegwell and Ramsgate, on or after 21 September 2015.

The roads affected, planned dates of closure and alternative routes are as shown below.

DOWNS ROAD, RAMSGATE - closed between Goodwin Road and Convent Walk

21 September 2015 with estimated completion by 6 November

The alternative routes are

Northbound via Chilton Lane, B2054 London Road,

Southbound Pegwell Road, St Mildred's Avenue and Minster Road

MINSTER ROAD, RAMSGATE - closed between Goodwin Road and St Lawrence Avenue

5 October 2015 with estimated completion by 20 November

The alternative routes are

Northbound via Goodwin Road, B2054 London Road, St Mildred's Avenue and Minster Road

Southbound via Goodwin Road, Pegwell Road and St

ROYAL ESPLANADE, RAMSGATE - westbound carriageway (i.e. away from Ramsgate) closed in phases, as signposted on site

5 October 2015 with estimated completion by 25 March 2016

The alternative route for westbound traffic is via Grange Road, B2054 London Road, Pegwell Road, St Lawrence Avenue and Royal Esplanade

Access for residents and businesses will be maintained, as advised locally.

Eastbound traffic is unaffected.

ST LAWRENCE AVENUE, RAMSGATE - northbound closure (i.e. away from coast) between the junctions with Royal Esplanade and Minster Road 9 November 2015 with estimated completion by 15 March 2016

The alternative route for northbound traffic is via Royal Esplanade, St Mildred's Avenue and Minster Road Southbound traffic is unaffected

The timing of the phases is approximate and likely to be affected by weather and ground conditions. The exact dates will be notified to local residents and signposted on site.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the roads outside the working hours.
