

Highways

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

THANET AREA

BOUNDARY ROAD & CHATHAM STREET, RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of works to provide a new gas supply together with remedial works to manhole covers, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on the junction between A255 Boundary Road and A254 Chatham Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned for Sunday 15 May 2016, starting from 08:00 hours and continuing through until Monday 16 May 2016 at 06:00 hours.

The signal-controlled junction where A255 Park Road / Boundary Road meets A254 Margate Road / Chatham Street will be fully closed.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via A255 Park Road, High Street St Lawrence, Nethercourt Hill, B2054 London Road, Grange Road, St Augustine's Road, Paragon, Royal Parade, Harbour Parade, Madeira Walk, Wellington Crescent, Victoria Parade and Victoria Road.

The junction closure will have the following effects: A254 MARGATE ROAD closed between Shah Place and the traffic lights. Traffic will be diverted via Shah Place and Park Road (and vice versa) to join the diversion above

A254 CHATHAM STREET will be closed between the traffic lights and the junction with Chatham Place.

Chatham Street can be accessed from a western direction via High Street or from an eastern direction via Boundary Road and Chatham Place.

A255 PARK ROAD / BOUNDARY ROAD will be closed from the junction with Shah Place to the traffic lights.

Eastbound traffic on Park Road can reach Margate Road via Shah Place.

COTTINGTON ROAD, MINSTER (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of carriageway resurfacing works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Cottington Road, Minster, Thanet.

A closure is planned for Friday 13 May 2016 between 09:00 hours and approximately 15:00 hours.

Cottington Road will be closed between the junctions with Thorne Hill / Ebbsfleet Lane and Cottington Link, with no through access during works.

The alternative route is via Cottington Link Road, A299 Hengist way - Tothill Street, Foxborough Lane, The Lanes and Grinsell Hill.

Access remains from either direction up to where Cottington Road is closed, but there will be no through access.

LOMBARD STREET, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of works to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Lombard Street, Margate.

A closure is planned to start from Monday 9 May 2016 for an estimated period of up to 2 days.

Lombard Street will be closed in the vicinity of number 7, with no through access between the junctions with New Cross Street and Hawley Street.

The alternative route is via New Cross Street, New Street and B2055 Hawley Street.

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of New Cross Street will be reversed so it flows southbound towards New Street, to allow its use as the diversion.

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of Lombard Street will be suspended between the junctions with New Cross Street and B2055 Hawley Street, to allow limited access / exit up to where the road is closed.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

MANSTON COURT ROAD, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

To allow safe access to underground structures for phone cabling works to provide a new connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Manston Court Road, Margate.

Off-peak closures are planned to commence from Tuesday 10 May 2016 for up to 2 days, between 09:30 hours and 15:30 hours each day.

Manston Court Road will be closed in the vicinity of Bradgate Park Holiday Park, with no through access between the junctions with Vincent Road and Valley Road.

Access remains from either direction up to where the Manston Court Road is closed, but there will be no through access.

The alternative route is via B2050 Manston Road, A256 Haine Road, New Haine Road, Star Lane Link, Star Lane and Manston Court Road.

NORTHWOOD ROAD, BROADSTAIRS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of carriageway resurfacing works on the Westwood Road / Northwood Road Roundabout, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Northwood Road, Broadstairs.

Overnight closures are planned from Monday 9 May 2016 for up to 4 weekday nights, between 19:30 hours through until 05:00 hours each night.

Northwood Road will be closed from the roundabout junction with A256 Westwood Road as far as the junction with Sycamore Close.

The alternative route is via A256 Westwood Road, Pearce Signs Roundabout and A254 Margate Road.

The closure is in conjunction with temporary traffic lights on A256 Westwood Road / Northwood Road roundabout.

Access to the remainder of Northwood Road continues from the Margate Road direction.

ST JOHN'S AVENUE, RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of gas mains replacement works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of St John's Avenue, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned to commence from Saturday 28 May 2016 with estimated completion by 10 June 2016.

St John's Avenue will be closed in the vicinity of the junction with A256 Haine Road, so that there is no access between Haine Road and St John's Avenue.

The alternative route is via A256 Haine Road, B2060 Manston Road, B2014 Newington Road, Bush Avenue and St John's Avenue.

Access to the remainder of St John's Avenue continues from the Newington Road direction.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
