

## Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

### ASHFORD AREA

#### A2042 FAVERSHAM ROAD, ASHFORD (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

To allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A2042 Faversham Road, Ashford.

Overnight closures are planned to start from Monday 27 June 2016 for up to 4 nights, between 19:30 hours through until 05:00 hours each night

A2042 Faversham Road will be closed between the junctions with A28 Canterbury Road and Northumberland Avenue, with no through access during works.

The alternative route is via A251 Trinity Road, Junction 9 Interchange, A20 Fougères Way, Drivers Roundabout, Simone Weil Avenue and A28 Canterbury Road.

Access remains from the Trinity Road direction up to where Faversham Road is closed, but there will be no through access to A28 Canterbury Road.

#### THE STREET, WESTWELL (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of kerbing works together with works to replace broken gullies, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of The Street, Westwell, Ashford

Daytime closures are planned from Monday 11 July 2016 for an estimated period of up to 2 weeks

The Street, Westwell will be closed to through traffic between the junctions with Watery Lane and Westwell Lane, with no through access during the works

The alternative route is via Watery Lane, A20 Maidstone Road and Westwell Lane

### CANTERBURY AREA

#### CHURCH LANE, WALTHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of works to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Church Lane, Waltham, Canterbury.

A closure is planned to commence from Monday 11 July 2016 for an estimated period of up to 5 days

Church Lane, Waltham will be closed in the vicinity of Rose Cottages, just to the east of the junction with Kake Street / Woods Hill. Access to the remainder of Church Lane continues from the eastern (Whiteacre Lane) direction up to where the road is closed.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Woods Hill (Richdore Road), Whiteacre Lane and Church Lane.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

#### GROVE ROAD, WICKHAMBREAUX (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

To allow carriageway patching and drainage improvement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Grove Road, Wickhambreaux, Canterbury

Daytime closures are planned to commence from Tuesday 12 July 2016 for up to 4 days, from 08:00 hours through to approximately 17:00 hours each day

Grove Road will be closed between the junctions with The List (Wickhambreaux) and Grove Ferry Road, with no through access during works

The alternative route for all through traffic is via Grove Road, Wickham Road, Nargate Street, A257 High Street (Littlebourne) / Wingham Road / Canterbury Road / High Street (Wingham), Preston Hill, Preston Road, Preston Lane, The Street and Grove Road

#### MARLEY LANE, KINGSTON (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of works to provide a new telegraph pole for a new customer phone connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Marley Lane, Kingston, Canterbury.

An off-peak closure is planned for Monday 27 June 2016, from 09:30 hours to approximately 15:30 hours.

Marley Lane will be closed between the junctions with Turks Hill and Westwood Road, with no through access during works.

The alternative routes are

*Westbound* via Westwood Road and Turks Hill

*Eastbound* via Turks Hill, Covet Lane, Bonny Bush Hill and The Street

#### NORTH LANE, CANTERBURY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of carriageway resurfacing works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of North Lane, Canterbury.

Overnight closures are planned to start from Tuesday 28 June 2016 for up to 2 nights, from 19:30 hours through to 05:00 hours each night

North Lane will be closed from the roundabout junction with Station Road West, south-westwards to a point in the vicinity of The Flower Studio

Access to the remainder of North Lane continues from the St Dunstan's Street direction.

The alternative route is via A290 St Dunstan's Street and B2248 Station Road West.

The Causeway will be closed at the junction with North Lane, with access remaining from the Pound Lane direction.

#### STATION ROAD, BEKESBOURNE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of drainage improvement works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Station Road, Bekesbourne, Canterbury.

A closure is planned to commence from Monday 27 June 2016 for an estimated period of up to 2 weeks.

Station Road will be closed between the junctions with Cranmer Close and School Lane, with no through access during these works.

The alternative route is via Bifrons Hill, Bekesbourne Rd, A2050 Dover Road, New Dover Road, A257 Lower Chantry Lane, Longport, St Martin's Hill, Littlebourne Road, Canterbury Road, The Hill, High Street and Bekesbourne Lane.

Access remains from either direction up to where Station Road is closed, but there will be no through access.

Due to the extensive nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

### DARTFORD AREA

#### (VARIOUS ROADS, DARTFORD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) CONSOLIDATION (AMENDMENT No.18) ORDER 2016

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

- The effect of the proposed named Order will introduce or amend existing waiting restrictions in the following lengths of road (in this part of the notice DYL's means double yellow lines) waiting to be prohibited at any time

#### Black Eagle Drive, Northfleet

- both sides from its junction with Robinson Way in a southerly direction for a distance of 9 metres.
- the east side from a point 31 metres south of its junction with Robinson Way in a southerly direction for a distance of 17 metres.
- the east side from a point 70 metres south of its junction with Robinson Way in a southerly then easterly direction to its cul-de-sac end.
- the west side from a point 34 metres south of its junction with Robinson Way in a southerly direction for a distance of 17 metres.
- the west side from a point 63 metres south of its junction with Robinson Way in a southerly then easterly direction to its cul-de-sac end.

#### Robinson Way, Northfleet

- the north side from its junction with Snowden Hill in an easterly direction to its cul-de-sac end.
- the north side from a point opposite the boundary of Nos. 40/42 in an easterly direction to its junction with Snowden Hill.
- the south side from a point opposite and 2 metres east of the boundary of Nos. 39/41 in a westerly direction for a distance of 6 metres.
- the south side from its junction with Black Eagle Drive in a westerly direction for a distance of 28 metres.
- the south side from a point opposite and 1 metre west of the boundary of Nos. 47/49 in a westerly direction to its junction with Black Eagle Drive.
- the south side from a point 5 metres west of its cul-de-sac end in an easterly direction to its cul-de-sac end.
- the south and west side from the boundary of Nos. 40/42 in a southerly then easterly direction to a point opposite and 1 metre west of the boundary of Nos. 29/31.

#### Snowden Hill, Northfleet

- both sides from its junction with Galley Hill Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 28 metres.
- the east side from a point opposite the northern property boundary of No.1 in a northerly direction for a distance of 15 metres.
- the east side from its junction with Robinson Way in a northerly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
- the west side from a point 7 metres north of the northern property boundary of No.1 in a northerly direction for a distance of 8 metres.
- the west side from its junction with Robinson Way in a northerly direction for a distance of 14 metres.

- The effect of the proposed named Order will introduce or amend existing waiting restrictions in the following lengths of road (in this part of the notice SYL's means single yellow lines) No Waiting Monday to Saturday 10.00am - 11am and 2 - 3pm

#### Mercer Avenue, Ebbsfleet

- the east side from a point 3 metres south of the boundary of Nos.2/4 to its junction with the Northern Access Road.
- the east side from a point 10 metres north of its junction with Park View to its western end.
- the west side from its junction with the Northern Access Road to a point 1 metre south-west of the boundary of Nos.23/25.

- the north side from a point 5 metres east of the boundary of Nos.27/29 in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.

#### Park View, Ebbsfleet

- the north side from its junction with Mercer Avenue to a point 9 metres east of the boundary of Nos. 14/16.
- the north side from a point 11 metres east of the boundary of Nos.16/18 to its cul-de-sac end.
- the south side from its cul-de-sac end to a point 13 metres east of the boundary of Nos.15/17.
- the south side from a point 4 metres east of the boundary of Nos.15/17 to its junction with Mercer Avenue.

#### Merrill Close, Ebbsfleet

- the east side from its junction with Park View to a point 4 metres south of the boundary of Nos.11/12.
- the east side from a point 9 metres north of the boundary of Nos.11/12 to its cul-de-sac end.
- the west side from its cul-de-sac end to a point 8 metres north of the boundary of Nos.3/4.
- the west side from a point 1 metre south of the boundary of Nos.3/4 to its junction with Park View.

#### Elinor Vale, Ebbsfleet

- the north side from its junction with Mercer Avenue in a westerly direction to its cul-de-sac end.
- the south side from its cul-de-sac end in an easterly direction to a point 14 metres west of the boundary of Nos. 7/8.
- the south side from a point 4 metres south-west of the boundary of Nos. 7/8 in an easterly direction to a point 2 metres south-east of the boundary of Nos. 1/2.
- the south-west side from a point 19 metres south-east of the boundary of Nos. 1/2 to its junction with Mercer Avenue.

#### Walker Close, Ebbsfleet

- both sides from its junction with Elinor Vale in a northerly direction to its cul-de-sac end.

#### Mansion Rise, Ebbsfleet

- the north side from its junction with Mercer Avenue to a point 2 metres east of the eastern boundary of No. 3 Hazel Mews.
- the north side from a point 1 metre east of its eastern boundary with Hazel Mews to a point 12 metres east of the boundary of Nos.9/10 Mansion Rise.
- the north side from a point 5 metres east of the boundary of Nos.8/9 in a westerly direction to its cul-de-sac end.
- the south side from its junction with Mercer Avenue in a westerly direction to its cul-de-sac end.

#### Weldon Road, Ebbsfleet

- the north side from its junction with Mercer Avenue in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 7 metres.
- the north side from a point 31 metres to the south-east of its junction with Mercer Avenue in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 3 metres.
- the north side from a point 7 metres north-east of a point level with the boundary of Nos.13/15 in an easterly direction for a distance of 7 metres.
- the north side from a point 7 metres west of the boundary of Nos.6/8 to a point 2 metres south-west of the boundary of Nos.10/12.
- the north side from a point 15 metres north-east of the boundary of Nos.10/12 in a north-easterly direction to its cul-de-sac end.
- the south side from a point level with the boundary of Nos.17/19 in an easterly direction to its cul-de-sac end.
- the south side from a point 11 metres west of the boundary of Nos.17/19 to its junction with Mercer Avenue.

#### Lett Lane, Ebbsfleet

- the north-east side from its junction with Weldon Road in a southerly direction to its southern end.
- the south-west side from its junction with Weldon Road to a point level with the northern boundary of No.2.
- the south-west side from its southern end in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 3 metres.

#### Rosina Grove, Ebbsfleet

- the east side from its junction with Mercer Avenue in a southerly direction to the boundary of 8 and 10 Rosina Grove.
- the east side from a point 3 metres south of the boundary of 10 and 12 Rosina Grove to its southern end.
- the west side from its junction with Mercer Avenue in a southerly direction for a distance of 11 metres.

- the west side from a point 3 metres north of the boundary of Nos.1/3 in a southerly direction to its southern end

- The effect of the proposed named Order will introduce or amend existing waiting restrictions in the following lengths of road (in this part of the notice SYL's means single yellow lines) No Waiting Monday to Saturday 8.00am to 6.00pm 3 hours no return for 3 hours

#### Mercer Avenue, Ebbsfleet

- the south-east side from a point 10 metres north of its junction with Park View to a point 3 metres south of the boundary of Nos.2/4.
- the north side from a point 5 metres to the east of the boundary of Nos.27/29 in an easterly direction for a distance of 7 metres.
- the north side from a point 4 metres west of the boundary of Nos.27/29 in a westerly direction for a distance of 22 metres.

#### Park View, Ebbsfleet

- the north side from a point 3 metres west of the boundary of Nos.16/18 in an easterly direction for a distance of 14 metres.
- the south side from a point 4 metres east of the boundary of Nos.15/17 in an easterly direction for a distance of 9 metres.

#### Merrill Close, Ebbsfleet

- the east side from a point 4 metres south of the boundary of Nos.11/12 in a northerly direction for a distance of 13 metres.
- the west side from a point 1 metre south of the boundary of Nos.3/4 in a northerly direction for a distance of 9 metres.

#### Elinor Vale, Ebbsfleet

- the south-west side from a point 11 metres north-west of its junction with Mercer Avenue in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 17 metres.
- south-east side from a point 14 metres west of the boundary of Nos.7/8 to a point 4 metres to the west of the boundary of Nos.7/8.

#### Mansion Rise, Ebbsfleet

- the north side from a point 2 metres east of the eastern boundary of No. 3 Hazel Mews in a westerly direction for a distance of 9 metres.
- the north side from a point 5 metres east of the boundary of Nos.8/9 in an easterly direction for a distance of 19 metres.

#### Weldon Road, Ebbsfleet

- the north-east side from a point 7 metres south-east of its junction with Mercer Avenue in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 24 metres.
- the north side from a point 1 metre east the boundary of Nos.7/9 in an easterly direction for a distance of 25 metres.
- the north-west side from a point level with its junction with Lett Lane in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 18 metres.
- the south side from a point level with the boundary of Nos.17/19 in a westerly direction for a distance of 11 metres.
- the north side from a point 2 metres south-west of the boundary of Nos.10/12 in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 17 metres.

#### Rosina Grove, Ebbsfleet

- the west side from a point 3 metres north of the boundary of No.1/3 in a northerly direction for a distance of 15 metres
- the east side from the boundary of 8 and 10 Rosina Grove to a point 3 metres south of the boundary of 10 and 12 Rosina Grove

#### Lett Lane, Ebbsfleet

- The south-west side from a point level with the boundary of No.2 in a southerly direction for a distance of 14 metres

The effect of the proposed named Order will introduce parking for Disabled Badge Holders Only

#### Cavell Crescent, Dartford

- The south side from the boundary of Nos. 34/36 in an easterly direction for a distance of 11 metres.
