

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

MAIDSTONE AND TUNBRIDGE WELLS AREAS

VARIOUS ROADS, MAIDSTONE & TUNBRIDGE WELLS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of the road stud replacement following carriageway surface treatment works, Kent County Council has made an order to prohibit traffic on the routes described in the Schedule below.

The Order will come into operation on 1st July 2016 and will be valid for a maximum period of 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is sooner.

Planned dates will be indicated by signage displayed on site 7 days in advance. Road closures and other restrictions will be in effect when the appropriate signage and barriers are in place.

This programme is subject to weather and other factors and may therefore change; every effort will be made to keep as close as possible to the programmed dates and duration. Changes will be notified locally and signposted on site.

SCHEDULE TUNBRIDGE WELLS

FIVE OAK GREEN, FIVE OAK GREEN – Whested Road to Alders Road.

Working times :18.30hrs to 06.00hrs for up to 2 nights.

Diversion is via Five Oak Green Road, Crockhurst Street, Tudeley Road, Woodgate Way, A21 Pembury bypass (Vauxhall Lane), A228 Tonbridge Road, A228 Maidstone Road (Colts Hill), B2162 Badsell Road, Five Oak Green Road and vice versa.

PENSHURST ROAD – Hayesden Lane to Poundsbridge Lane.

Working times- 18.30hrs to 06.00hrs for up to 2 nights.

Diversion via Haysden Lane, Ensfield Road, Lower Green Road, Leigh, Penshurst Road, Penshurst Lane, Penshurst Road, Rogues Hill, Penshurst Road, Bidborough and vice versa.

A229 KNOXBRIDGE, FRITTENDEN – Grandshore Lane to Knoxbridge.

Working times 18.30hrs to 06.00hrs for up to 2 nights.

Diversion via Rocks Hill, A262 The Street, A274 North Street, Headcorn Road, Biddenden Road, Wheeler Street, Station Road, High Street, North Street, Mill Bank, Maidstone Road,, Headcorn Road, North Street, Maidstone Road, B2163 Plough Wents Road, Heath Road, A229 Linton Hill, Staplehurst Road, Maidstone Road, Station Road and vice versa.

A274 MAIDSTONE ROAD, HEADCORN – New Barn Road to East Sutton Road (Plumtree Road)

Working Times 18.30hrs to 06.00hrs for up 2 nights.

Diversion via- Maidstone Road, North Street, Headcorn High Street, Wheeler Street, Biddenden Road, A262 Biddenden High Street, A262 Sissinghurst Road, Biddenden Road, High Street, Sissinghurst, Goudhurst Road, A229 Willesley Pound, The Common, Rocks Hill, Knoxbridge, Cranbrook Road, High Street, Staplehurst, A274 Station Road, Staplehurst, Maidstone Road, Headcorn, Loose Road, A275 Sutton Road, Maidstone Road, Headcorn Road and vice versa

SEVENOAKS AREA

BROAD LANE, PENSHURST (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of works to an overhead BT structure, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on Broad Lane, Penshurst, on or after 14 July 2016 for up to 1 day between 09:30hrs and 15:30hrs or until the works have been completed.

There will be no access for through traffic between the junctions with A264 Ashurst Road and Chafford Lane.

The alternative route is via Chafford Lane, B2188 Fordcombe Road and A264 Ashurst Road.

HARROW ROAD, KNOCKHOLT (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because BT require safe access to work on an underground structure, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Harrow Road, Knockholt, on or after 3rd July 2016 for up 1 day between the hours of 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside Cotts.

The alternative route is via Main Road, Old London Road and vice versa.

POND LAND & STONE STREET, SEAL (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of the installation of fibre optic cables, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Pond Land and Stone Street, Seal, as per the schedule below or until the works have been completed.

SCHEDULE

Pond Lane, Seal – between Bitchet Green Road, Blakes Green Road and Stone Street
1 July 2016 for up to 14 days
The alternative route is via Bitchet Green Road, Blakes Green Road and Stone Street.

Stone Street – from Pond Lane to outside Clemmens 15 July 2016 for up to 14 days
The alternative route is via Church Road, A25 Maidstone Road and Coach Road.

The Order will extend the Guildhall North Parking Zone to include Millfield, Folkestone.

Permits will be available to a resident of Millfield, Folkestone and to any business or organisation with vehicle(s) essential to its operation.

Waiting will be prohibited at all times at the junctions where parking is not allowed.

MOCKBEGGAR, RHODES MINNIS & BOYKE LANE, ELHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

To allow carriageway patching works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Mockbeggar, Rhodes Minnis and Boyke Lane, Elham, in the Shepway area.

Daytime closures start from 29 June 2016 as shown below, and will be between the hours 09:00 hours and approximately 16:30 hours each day

MOCKBEGGAR, RHODES MINNIS will be closed in the vicinity of the junction with B2068 Stone Street, with no through access.

Daytime closures planned from Wednesday 29 June 2016 for up to 4 weekdays

The alternative route is via B2068 Stone Street, Hempstead Lane, Green Lane and The Minnis

BOYKE LANE, ELHAM will be closed between the junctions with White Horse Lane and Canterbury Road, with no through access during works.

Daytime closures planned from Wednesday 6 July 2016 for up to 3 days
The alternative route is White Horse Lane, Longage Hill and Canterbury Road

STONE STREET, STANFORD (THE WAR AND PEACE REVIVAL) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

For the safety of the public and to reduce the likelihood of congestion during The War and Peace Revival event, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Stone Street, Westenhanger, Stanford (Folkestone). Please note this applies to the *cul-de-sac* section of Stone Street, south of the M20 motorway

Stone Street, Stanford will be closed from Wednesday 13 July 2016 at 08:00 hours continuing through until Sunday 24 July at 16:00 hours

Stone Street will be closed from A20 Ashford Road northwards to the entrance to Folkestone Racecourse

Access for residents and their visitors will be maintained 24 hours per day by means of security operatives dressed in high visibility clothing

WEST HYTHE ROAD, HYTHE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

To allow carriageway patching works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of West Hythe Road, Hythe.

Daytime closures are planned from Monday 27 June 2016 for up to 3 days, between 09:00 hours and 16:00 hours each day.

West Hythe Road will be closed from the junction with Burmarsh Road northwards towards the property 'Sandyridge' at the western end of West Hythe village, with no through access during these works.

Access to West Hythe itself remains from the Lympne Hill direction.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via Burmarsh Road, A259 Dymchurch Road, Scanlons Bridge Road, A261 London Road, Hythe Road, Stone Street (Lympne), Aldington Road and Lympne Hill.

THE DISTRICT OF SHEPWAY (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2016 (Amendment 1)

NOTICE OF MAKING

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL intend to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

The Order proposes to introduce the following restrictions in the roads listed below:

Prohibition of waiting at any time

Roads in Folkestone:

Coolinge Lane, east side- from a point opposite the back of No 14 The Acers for a distance of 18 metres in a northerly direction; Earls Avenue, south west side- from boundary of No 11 Earls Avenue for a distance of 5 metres in northerly direction; **Sandgate Road**, south side- from the junction of Earls Avenue for distance of 28 metres in a westerly direction; **Rosendale Gardens**- both sides of Rosendale Court flats entrance for a distance of 5 metres; **Meadowbrook, Sandgate**- south-west side, from a point outside side entrance of 35 Enbrook Road for a distance of 22 metres in a westerly direction.

Roads in Hythe:

Cinque Ports Avenue, east side- from boundary of No 7 for a distance of 29 metres in a south westerly direction.

Roads in Dymchurch
Seabourne Way, west side- from the junction of St Marys Road for a distance of 35 metres in southerly direction; east side- from the junction of St Marys Road for a distance of 29 metres in a southerly direction.

Prohibition of waiting- 8am-6pm, Monday-Saturday (both days inclusive).

Roads in Hythe
Mill Road- North Side from the junction of Lower Blackhouse Hill for a distance of 74.5 metres in an easterly direction; **Great Conduit Street**- both sides, for its entire length.

Prohibition of waiting by motor caravans- 6pm-7am, Monday-Sunday (both days inclusive).

Roads in Folkestone
The Leas- both sides for its entire length; **Harbour Approach Road**- both sides for its entire length

Roads in Hythe
West Parade- both sides for its entire length.

Prohibition of verge and pavement parking (at any time).

Rosendale Gardens, Folkestone- south side- for its entire length; **Enbrook Valley, Sandgate**- west side for its entire length.

Limited waiting 2 hours no return within 4 hours 8am – 6pm Mondays to Sundays (both days inclusive).

High Street, New Romney

North side, from a point 35 metres east of its junction with Rome Road to a point 22 metres west of its junction with Ashford Road;

North side, from a point 30 metres east of its junction with Ashford Road to a point 16 metres in a westerly direction;

North side- from a point outside property boundary number 84-88 for a distance of 80.2 metres in an easterly direction.

The Order proposes to revoke the following parking restrictions:

Prohibition of waiting [At any time]

Roads in Dymchurch

Burmash Road

East side- from a point 5 metres from the junction of Kingsway for a distance of 67.5 metres.

Tritton Gardens

North west side- from the junction of Burmarsh Road for a distance of 11.7 metres; South west side- from its junction with Burmarsh Road for a distance of 14.5 metres.
