(1) PUBLIC FOOTPATHS (HE122 (PART) HE124 AND HE125 ACRISE) PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT ORDER 2016

(2) PUBLIC FOOTPATH (HE122A ACRISE) PUBLIC PATH CREATION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2016

On the Fifth day of September 2016 the Kent County Council confirmed the above Orders under Section 118 and 26 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the above Extinguishment Order as confirmed **extinguishes**: The entire width of (i) that part of Public Footpath numbered HE122 commencing from a point at the junction with HE124 (GR2046 4207) and running in a south westerly direction for 114 metres to its junction with Public Footpath HE 122 (GR2035 4203). As shown between the points B and E on the Order Plan and (ii) the entire width of that length of Public Footpath HE124 commencing from a point on Oak Hill (C212) (GR2028 4170) 10 metres to the east of the property known as White Gates Lodge and running in a north easterly direction for 640 metres to its junction with Public Footpath HE123 (GR2055 4228), as shown between the points A, B and C on the Order Plan and (iii) the entire width of that length of public footpath HE125 commencing from its junction with Public Footpath HE123 (GR2055 4228) 94 metres north-north west of Ridge Row (D1726) and running for 130 metres in a south easterly direction to its junction with Ridge Row (D1726) (GR2058 4215). As shown between the points C and D on the Order Plan.

The effect of the above Creation Order as confirmed **creates** a new length of Public Footpath numbered HE122A with a width of two metres commencing from a point on the existing line of Public Footpath HE122 (GR2035 4203) 114 metres south west of the junction of Footpaths HE122 and HE124 and running in a East South Easterly direction, running parallel to the northern side of the existing boundary fence but 3 metres out from it, for 120 metres to (GR2047 4199), then in an East North East through East South East direction for approximately 32 metres passing through a Kissing Gate to the north of the existing Farm Gates to connect with the Public Highway known as Ridge Row (D1726)(GR2050 4199) As shown between the points E, F and G on the Order Plan.

All distances are approximate, all directions are general.

The Orders came into force on the 5th September 2016, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question their validity, or that of any provision contained in them, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act which has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, he or she may under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from the 23rd day of September 2016, make an application to the High Court.

The above named Order made on 15th September 2016 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert the entire width of that length of public footpath numbered ZR634 which commences on Brenley Lane at NGR TR 0411 5901 (point A) and runs south-east for 211.0 metres to NGR TR 0427 5887 (point B), between the points A-B on the Order plan, and will add a new length of public footpath numbered ZR634, with a width of 2.5 metres starting 0.5 metre from the root of the hedge lines, which commences at the aforementioned point A and runs south for 45.0 metres to NGR TR 0411 5897 (point C), then south-east for 186.0 metres to NGR TR 0426 5887 (point D), and then north-east for 9.0 metres to the aforementioned point B, between the points A-C-D-B on the Order plan.

If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
