

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

The Order will become effective on 9th October 2016 between 09.00hrs and 12.30hrs. The restrictions/prohibitions specified in this notice will apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs in operation.

Nothing in the Order will apply to:

- Any Vehicle being used for Ambulance purposes, Coastguard/RNLI, Fire Brigade or Police services.
- Anything done by a Statutory Undertaker vehicle in connection with an emergency repair.
- Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a KCC Traffic Marshal, Event Organisers or a Police Constable in Uniform

VARIOUS ROADS, SEVENOAKS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of carriageway repairs, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on Various Roads, Sevenoaks, as per the schedule below or until the works have been completed.

SCHEDULE

Top Hill, Chiddingstone – Bradley Road to Coldharbour Road

10 October 2016 for up to 3 days

The diversion route is via Coldharbour Road, Nuntery Lane, Walters Green Road and Bradley Road

Poundsbridge Lane, Penshurst – B2176 Penshurst Road to Poundsbridge

13 October 2016 for up to 3 days

The diversion route is via B2176 Penshurst Road/Rogues Hill/High Street, B2188 High Street/Fordcombe Road/New Road/Saints Hill/Spring Hill, The Lane, Poundsbridge Lane, Poundsbridge Hill and Poundsbridge

St Julian's Road, Seal – the fork between St Julian's Road and Park Lane

24 October 2016 for up to 3 days between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs

The diversion route is via St Julian's Road and Park Lane

Pigdown Lane, Hever – Rectory Lane to Uckfield Lane

24 October 2016 for up to 3 days

The diversion route is via Rectory Lane, Wilderness Lane, Buckhurst and Uckfield Lane

How Green Lane, Hever – B2027 Clinton Lane to Hever Road

24 October 2016 for up to 4 days

The diversion route is via B2027 Clinton Lane and Hever Road

St Julian's Road, Seal – A225 Riverhill to Fawke Wood Road

25 October 2016 for up to 4 days between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs

The diversion route is via Park Lane, Blackhall Lane, B2019 Seal Hollow Road, A225 High Street/Tonbridge Road/Riverhill

Carter's Hill, Underriver – St Julian's Road to Fawke Wood Road

1 November 2016 for up to 3 days

The diversion route is via Carter's Hill, Bank Lane, B245 London Road, A225 Morleys roundabout/B245 London Road, A225 Riverhill and St Julian's Road

SHEPWAY AREA

A260 SPITFIRE WAY, HAWKINGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

To allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit southbound traffic on part of the A260 Spitfire Way, Hawkinge, in the Folkestone area.

Overnight closures are planned from Monday 26 September 2016 for up to 2 nights, from 19:30 hours through until 05:00 hours each night.

A260 Spitfire Way will be closed southbound only (towards Folkestone), from the roundabout junction with Haven Drive / Swann Way down to the White Horse Hill Roundabout.

The alternative route is via Canterbury Road (Hawkinge) and White Horse Hill.

Northbound (uphill) traffic is unaffected but the outside (overtaking) lane will be closed opposite the southbound closure, which may result in slight delays.

Southbound access to the remainder of Spitfire Way continues from the northern direction, but there will be no through access.

PALMBEACH AVENUE, HYTHE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

To allow works to install new gravity fall manhole as part of drainage works for the future Martello Lakes development to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Palmbeach Avenue, Hythe.

A closure is planned to start from Wednesday 28 September 2016 with estimated completion by 5 October.

Palmbeach Avenue will be closed in the vicinity of house numbers 22 & 24.

Access to part of Palmbeach Avenue continues from A259 Dymchurch Road, or for houses beyond the closure, via Palmmarsh Avenue.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 (PUFFIN CROSSING)

Notice is hereby given that Kent County Council, as local traffic authority, and after consultation with the chief officer of police, proposes to establish a crossing (Toucan) under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all their enabling powers, as follows:

CHURCH ROAD, CHERITON: Located approximately 50m East of the junction with Horn Street

SWALE AREA

COURTENAY ROAD & DAWES ROAD, DUNKIRK (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

To allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Courtenay Road and Dawes Road, Dunkirk, near Faversham.

Phased closures are planned from Saturday 1 October 2016 for an estimated period of up to 5 weeks, between 07:00 hours and 19:00 hours each day.

Courtenay Road and Dawes Road will each be closed at various points long their entire lengths, to the extent indicated by signage on site.

The alternative route is (for Dawes Road also including Staplestreet Road) via Canterbury Road (Boughton Hill), A2 Boughton Bypass / Dover Road, A2050 Harbledown Bypass, Rheims Way, St Peter's Place, A290 St Dunstan's Street / Whitstable Road / St Thomas Hill/ Whitstable Road / Tile Kiln Hill / Blean Hill / Blean Common / Honey Hill, Denstroude Lane and Courtenay Road.

EASTCHURCH ROAD, MINSTER (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

For the safety of the workforce and public during carriageway resurfacing works, Kent County Council has made an Order to impose a temporary mandatory 30 mph speed limit on part of Eastchurch Road, Minster, Isle of Sheppey.

The speed limit applies in both directions on Eastchurch Road, from the existing 30 mph / National Speed Limit sign southwards and eastwards to the roundabout junction with Court Tree Drive.

The 30 mph speed limit applies from Monday 26 September 2016 for up to 2 days, as and when the relevant signs are clearly displayed on site

Due to the nature of these works, the 30 mph speed limit will remain in force at all times.

ELM LANE, MINSTER-ON-SEA (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

To allow repairs to a collapsed drainage ditch to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Elm Lane, Minster-on-Sea, Isle of Sheppey.

Weekday daytime closures are planned from Monday 10 October 2016 for an estimated period of up to 2 days, between 08:00 hours and 16:30 hours each day.

Elm Lane will be closed between the junctions with Scocles Road and Drake Avenue.

The alternative route is via Scocles Road, Back Lane, High Street (eastbound only), Chapel Street, Chequers Road and Elm Lane.

Access to the remainder of Elm Lane continues from either direction up to where the road is closed.

TONBRIDGE & MALLING AREA

COMMERCIAL ROAD, TONBRIDGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of a water pipe installation, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on Commercial Road, Tonbridge, on or after 14 October 2016 for up to 5 working days or until the works have been completed.

The whole of the road will be closed.

COMMON ROAD, IGHTHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of power cable works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on Common Road, Ightham, on or after 10 October 2016 for up to 4 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from Redwell Lane to outside "Brownsfield".

The alternative route is via Sandy Lane, Coach Road and Copt Hall Road.

MOTE ROAD, SHIPBOURNE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of drainage improvement works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on Mote Road, Shipbourne, on or after 13 October 2016 for up to 2 days or until the works have been completed.

The whole of the road will be closed.

The alternative route is via Hildenborough Road, A227 Ightham Road and High Cross Road.

TUNBRIDGE WELLS AREA

HOSPICE IN THE WEALD 10K RUN (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Kent County Council has made an Order for the safety of the public whilst an event is being held on the highway to temporarily prohibit the use of Vehicles on:-

Castle Road, A264 Church Road, A264 Mount Ephraim, A264 Bishop's Down, A264 Langton Road, Holmewood Ridge, Broom Lane, Hillswood Road, Fairview Lane, High Rocks Lane, Hungershall Park, Major York's Road, Castle Road.

The Order will become effective on 25th September 2016 between 0800hrs and 1400hrs. The restrictions/prohibitions specified in this notice will apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs in operation.

Nothing in the Order will apply to:

- Any Vehicle being used for Ambulance purposes, Coastguard/RNLI, Fire Brigade or Police services.
- Anything done by a Statutory Undertaker vehicle in connection with an emergency repair.
- Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a KCC Traffic Marshal, Event Organisers or a Police Constable in Uniform

STONEWALL PARK ROAD, LANGTON GREEN (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of gas main replacement works, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Stonewall Park Road, Langton Green, on or after 26 September 2016 for up to 3 weeks or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from A264 Langton Road to outside Chapel Cottage.

The alternative route is via A264 Langton Road and Salisbury Road.

THE MOOR, HAWKHURST (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of works to a BT underground structure, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on The Moor, Hawkhurst, on or after 10 October 2016 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

There will be no access for through traffic between the junctions with B2244 Hastings Road and A229 The Moor.

The alternative route is via B2244 Hastings Road and A229 The Moor.
