Highways

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

There will be no access for through traffic between the junctions with Brownings and Oakfield Road.

The alternative route is via B2026 Main Road, Spout Lane, Pootings Road, B2027 Four Elms Road and B2026 Main Road and vice versa.

BOTSOM LANE, WEST KINGSDOWN (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of carriageway patching, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on Botsom Lane, West Kingsdown, on or after 9 November 2016 for up to 4 days between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from Olive Cottage to Maplescombe Road.

Because of carriageway patching and installation of new signs and road markings, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Pilgrims Way East, Otford & Pilgrims Way, Kemsing, on or after 26 October 2016 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

There will be no access for through traffic between the junctions with A225 Station Road and Childsbridge Lane.

STYANTS BOTTOM ROAD, SEAL & IGHTHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of drainage cleansing, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on Styants Bottom Road, Seal and Ightham, on or after 9 November 2016 for up to 1 day between 09.00hrs and 16.00hrs or until the works have been completed.

The whole length of the road will be closed

The alternative route is via Watery Lane, Broad Oak Lane, A25 Maidstone Road/Sevenoaks Road and vice versa.

WEALD ROAD, SEVENOAKS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of electric cable works, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Weald Road, Sevenoaks, on or after 24 October 2016 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 33.

The alternative route is via Weald Road, Gracious Lane and A225 Tonbridge Road

VARIOUS ROADS, SEVENOAKS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Rockdale Road, Sevenoaks at the junction of High Street – 18:30hrs -21:30hrs

Oak Lane, Sevenoaks at the junction of Tonbridge Road – 18:30hrs -21:30hrs

Solefields Road, Sevenoaks at the junction of Tonbridge Road 18:30hrs – 21:30hrs

The Order will become effective on Saturday 5th November 2016. The restrictions/prohibitions specified in this notice will apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs in operation.

Nothing in the Order will apply to:

- Any Vehicle being used for Ambulance purposes, Coastguard/RNLI, Fire Brigade or Police services
- Anything done by a Statutory Undertaker vehicle in connection with an emergency repair
- Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a KCC Traffic Marshal, Event Organisers or a Police Constable in Uniform

SHEPWAY AREA

BARTHOLOMEW STREET, HYTHE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

To allow works to provide a new water connection to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bartholomew Street. Hythe.

Daytime closures are planned from Monday 24 October 2016 with estimated completion by 28 October.

Bartholomew Street will be closed in the vicinity of

The alternative route is via Hillside Street and Upper Malthouse Hill.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 10:00 hours and 16:00 hours each day, with the road re-opened outside these hours.

CHURCH ROAD & HORN STREET, CHERITON (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

To allow carriageway resurfacing to be carried out following junction modifications, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Church Road and Horn Street, Cheriton, near Folkestone.

A closure is planned from Monday 24 October 2016 for an estimated period of up to 1 week.

Church Road and Horn Street will be closed in the vicinity of the junction where they meet each other.

The alternative route is via Horn Street, A259 Seabrook Road, B2063 Hospital Hill / West Road / North Road / Military Road / Risborough Lane (note 14' 6" height restriction), B2064 Cheriton High Street, Cheriton Interchange, Cheriton High Street and Horn Street

Access to the remainder of Horn Street continues from either direction up to where the road is closed, and access to the remainder of Church Road continues from Risborough Lane.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the roads outside the working hours.

GIBRALTAR LANE, HAWKINGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2016

To allow works to provide a new water connection to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Gibraltar Lane, Hawkinge, near Folkestone.

A closure is planned for Monday 24 October 2016 for 1 day, from 09:00 hours through to approximately 16:00 hours.

Gibraltar Lane will be closed in the vicinity of Sunny Bank

Farm, with access from either direction up to where the road is closed, but no through access.

The alternative route is via Crete Road West and Elvington Lane.

SANDLING ROAD, SALTWOOD (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

To allow essential tree safety works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Sandling Road, Saltwood near Hythe.

SWALE AREA

LOWER RAINHAM ROAD, UPCHURCH (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

To allow trial hole works to be carried out for future sewer works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Lower Rainham Road, Upchurch (Swale).

Overnight closures are planned from Monday 24 October 2016 for up to 5 nights, from 20:00 hours through to approximately 06:00 hours each night.

Lower Rainham Road will be closed in the vicinity of the roundabout junction with Otterham Quay Lane.

School Lane will be closed in the vicinity of the junction with Holly Blue Drive.

Access to the remainder of School Lane continues from either direction up to where the road is closed, but there will be no through access.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via School Lane, Iwade Road, Stickfast Lane, Sheppey Way and Ferry Road back to School Lane, with the same applying in reverse.

TONBRIDGE & MALLING AREA

DRY HILL PARK ROAD, TONBRIDGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of carriageway resurfacing, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Dry Hill Park Road, Tonbridge, on or after 24th October 2016 for up to 5 Days or until the works have been completed. The road will be closed from B245 London Road to A227 Shiphourne Road.

The alternative route is via B245 London Road, A227 High Street, A227 Bordyke, A227 Hadlow Road, A26 Hadlow Road, Yardley Park Road and vice versa.

FORD LANE, TROTTISCLIFFE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of a water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Ford Lane, Trottiscliffe, on or after 24 October 2016 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

There will be no access for through traffic between the junctions with A20 London Road and Addington Lane.

The alternative route is via Addington Lane, Trottiscliffe Road and A20 London Road.

TUDELEY LANE, TONBRIDGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because a new gas service is to be installed, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Tudeley Lane, Tonbridge, on or after 24 October 2016 for up to 7 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside Weald of Kent Grammar School.

The alternative route is via Lodge Oak Lane, Kings Road and Goldsmid Road.

TUNBRIDGE WELLS AREA

AUCKLAND ROAD, TUNBRIDGE WELLS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Because of repairs to a stopcock, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Auckland Road, Tunbridge Wells, on or after 24 October 2016 for up to 10 working days or until the works have been completed.

There will be no access for through traffic between the junctions with Stanhope Road and Albion Road.

The alternative route is via Dorking Road and Albion Road.

YEW TREE GREEN ROAD, HORSMONDEN AND REYNOLDS LANE, TUNBRIDGE WELLS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016
