

**KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
CONSULTATION ON THE PROPOSED DISPOSAL OF
SURPLUS PLAYING FIELDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH
S77 OF THE SCHOOL STANDARDS AND FRAMEWORK
ACT 1998**

**LAND AT THE FORMER CHAUCER TECHNOLOGY
SCHOOL, SPRING LANE, CANTERBURY, KENT**

Kent County Council is proposing to dispose of part of this former school site and the capital receipt raised will be invested in the KCC education capital expenditure programme. The receipt from the sale of the playing field element will be prioritised towards the provision of new sports facilities and supporting infrastructure then towards the cost of new classrooms and associated expenditure.

The size of the site to be sold is approximately 1.94 ha comprising mostly the built area of the school site but of which the playing field element is as follows:

Hard games Courts: approximately 3340m²

Miscellaneous Informal Play Areas: approximately 1220m²

Miscellaneous hard play areas: approximately 2050m²

Please note that this notice does NOT relate to any of the former school's main grassed playing fields as these are not included in the proposed disposal area. In accordance with s77 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 Kent County Council is required to consult with local residents and the public with regard to the sale of the playing field land. The consultation is open until 16 January 2017.
