

Highways

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

THANET AREA

DANE HILL ROW, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new electricity supply, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Dane Hill Row, Margate .

A closure is planned from Monday 6 February 2017 for an estimated period of up to 5 days.

Dane Hill Row will be closed in the vicinity of number 15, with access from either direction up to where the road is closed, but no through access.

The alternative routes for through traffic are eastbound via Dane Hill, Northdown Rd and Bath Rd or westbound via Bath Rd, Dane Rd and Dane Hill.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

HOLLICONDANE ROAD, RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow safe access to underground apparatus in the carriageway to provide a phone service, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit eastbound traffic on part of Hollicondane Road, Ramsgate.

An overnight closure is are planned for Monday 6 February 2017 for up to 1 night, from 20:00 hours continuing through until 06:00 hours.

Hollicondane Road will be closed to eastbound traffic at the junction with A254 Margate Road, so that traffic will be unable to join Hollicondane Road from Margate Road.

The alternative route is via A254 Margate Road, A255 Boundary Road, Hardres Road, and St Luke's Avenue.

Traffic wishing to join Margate Road from Hollicondane Road is unaffected, and the remainder of Hollicondane Road can be reached from the northern direction up to where the road is closed.

ST JAMES PARK ROAD, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow gas mains replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of St James Park Road, Margate.

A closure is planned from Saturday 11 February 2017 with estimated completion by 19 February 2017.

St James Park Road will be closed in the vicinity of the eastern junction with A28 Canterbury Road.

Access to the remainder of St James Park Road continues from its western junction via A28 Canterbury Road.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

STIRLING WAY, RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow underground works to be carried out to provide a new electricity service, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Stirling Way, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from Saturday 28 January 2017 at 09:00 through until Sunday 29 January at approximately 17:00 hours.

Stirling Way will be closed to the west of the junction with Rockstone Way.

The alternative route is via Quetta Road and Rockstone Way

Access to the remainder of Stirling Way, Ramsgate continues from either direction up to where the road is closed.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

THE VALE, BROADSTAIRS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow urgent tree safety works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of The Vale, Broadstairs.

A closure is planned for Tuesday 24 January 2017 for up to 1 day, between 09:30 hours and approximately 15:00 hours.

The Vale will be closed in the vicinity of Inverness Terrace, with access from either direction up to where the road is closed, but no through access.

The alternative route is via Ramsgate Road and Luton Avenue.
