TM/17/00151/FL – 31 The Freehold Hadlow Tonbridge Kent TN11 0ES – Mr & Mrs Busby are applying for single storey rear extension, garage/store conversion and fenestration changes. Reason: CA HH

TM/17/00296/FL – The Shires Court Lane Hadlow Tonbridge Kent TN11 0JU – Mrs Forkgen is applying for removal of wooden shed. Erection of metal shed and greenhouse. Reason: LB HH
