

Highways

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

ASHFORD AREA

BROMLEY GREEN ROAD, RUCKINGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bromley Green Road, Ruckinge, in the Ashford area.

A closure is planned from Monday 5 June 2017 for an estimated period of up to 3 days.

Bromley Green Road will be closed in the vicinity of the property 'Oakdene', roughly mid-way along the road. The alternative route for through traffic is via Hamstreet Road and Capel Road.

Access to the remainder of Bromley Green Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed, but there will be no through access during these works.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

FRITH ROAD, ALDINGTON (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow drainage improvement works to be carried out to reduce the likelihood of flooding, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Frith Road, Aldington, near Ashford.

A closure is planned from Monday 22 May 2017 for an estimated period of up to 3 days.

Frith Road will be closed in the vicinity of Cranbourne Cottage, with no through access between the junctions with Coopers Lane and Laws Lane.

The alternative route is via Coopers Lane and Bank Road back to Frith Road.

Access to the remainder of Frith Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

MOCK LANE, GREAT CHART (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow drainage and construction works to be carried out in connection with a new development, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Mock Lane, Great Chart, near Ashford.

A closure is planned from Monday 22 May 2017 onwards and will remain in force until the works have been completed, currently estimated to be late autumn 2017.

Mock Lane will be closed from the junction with Chilmington Green Road eastwards for approximately 500 metres.

The alternative route is via Chilmington Green Road, A28 Ashford Road / Great Chart Bypass, Tithe Barn Lane and Bucksford Lane.

Due to the extensive nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

CANTERBURY AREA

DIAMOND ROAD & RESERVOIR ROAD, WHITSTABLE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow an internal sewer inspection to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Diamond Road and Reservoir Road, Whitstable.

A daytime closure is planned for Monday 5 June 2017, between 09:00 hours and approximately 16:00 hours.

Diamond Road and Reservoir Road will be closed in the vicinity of the junction where they meet each other.

The alternative route for Diamond Road is via Cromwell Road, Railway Avenue and Westmeads Road

The alternative route for Reservoir Road is via Cromwell Road, Westgate Terrace and Westmeads Road.

SANDOWN DRIVE, HERNE BAY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow works to be carried out to provide an electricity supply and sewer connection to a new dwelling, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Sandown Drive, Herne Bay.

A closure is planned from Monday 5 June 2017 for an estimated period of up to 5 days.

Sandown Drive will be closed in the vicinity of the junction with The Circus.

Access to the remainder of Sandown Drive continues from Sea Street direction up to where the road is actually closed, but there will be no through access during these works.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via The Circus, Albany Drive and B2205 Sea Street.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

STATION ROAD, BEKESBOURNE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow vegetation clearance near electricity cables to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Station Road, Bekesbourne, near Canterbury.

An off-peak closure is planned for Wednesday 24 May 2017 for up to 1 day, between 09:30 hours and

approximately 15:30 hours.

Station Road will be closed in the vicinity of Hillside Cottages, with no through access between the junctions with Bekesbourne Hill and School Lane.

The alternative route is via Bekesbourne Lane, A257 High Street, The Hill, Canterbury Road, Littlebourne Road, St Martin's Hill, Longport, Lower Chantry Lane, New Dover Road, Dover Road A2 off slip and Bifrons Hill (with the reverse direction using Bekesbourne Road and Bridge Hill).

Access to the remainder of Station Road, Bekesbourne continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

ST RADIGUND'S STREET, CANTERBURY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow building repairs to be safely carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of St Radigund's Street, Canterbury.

A closure is planned from Monday 5 June 2017 for an estimated period of up to 12 weeks.

St Radigund's Street will be closed opposite 'Computer Corner', west of the junction with Knotts Lane, with no through access between Knott's Lane and Mill Lane.

The alternative routes are

Eastbound via St Radigund's Street, The Causeway, B2248 St Stephen's Road, Kingsmead Road, Northgate, New Ruttington Lane, Victoria Row, Union Street and Northgate

Westbound via Knotts Lane, King Street, Borough, Northgate, B2248 Kingsmead Road, St Stephen's Road, North Lane and The Causeway

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

THE STREET, ADISHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow access to underground phone structures to enable cable de-silting works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of The Street, Adisham, in the Canterbury area.

An off-peak closure is planned for Monday 5 June 2017 for up to 1 day, between 09:30 hours and approximately 15:30 hours.

The Street will be closed from the junction with Pond Hill southwards for approximately 50 metres.

The alternative route is via Woodlands Road, Woodlands Lane, Poor Start Lane, Bramling Road, Adisham Downs Road and Pond Hill.

Access to the remainder of The Street continues from a southern direction up to where the road is actually closed, but there will be no through access during these works.

UB40 CONCERT, SPITFIRE GROUND, CANTERBURY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

For the safety of the public during the staging of a UB40 Concert, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily restrict traffic on certain roads in the vicinity of The Spitfire Ground, Canterbury.

Restrictions come into force on Saturday 3 June 2017 as shown below, and will remain in force until it is safe to lift them.

The following roads will be closed to the extent indicated, from 21:00 hours to approximately 23:30 hours, with local diversions signed on site.

B2068 ST LAWRENCE ROAD – closed for its entire length, with managed access from New Dover Road direction for taxis, buses and vehicles picking up passengers from the concert

B2068 NACKINGTON ROAD, CANTERBURY – fully closed between the junctions with The Foreland and Old Dover Road

OLD DOVER ROAD, CANTERBURY

• Closed in both directions between the junctions with Ethelbert Road and St Lawrence road, with alternative route via New Dover Road and Oaten Hill

• Closed northbound only between the junctions with New Dover Road and B2068 St Lawrence Road

The road closures do not apply to taxis or buses on stage carriage and park and ride services

Operatives on site will allow managed access for residents and visitors into locations where there are road closures

Waiting will be prohibited at all times on the following roads, as clearly indicated by No Waiting signs and cones on site

ST LAWRENCE ROAD – from 00:10 hours through to 23:30 hours, on both sides for its entire length

OLD DOVER ROAD – from 14:00 hours through to 23:30 hours, on both sides, between the junction with Ethelbert Road south-eastwards to the roundabout junction with New Dover Road

B2068 NACKINGTON ROAD – from 14:00 hours through to 23:30 hours, on both sides between the junctions with Old Dover Road and The Foreland

This Order suspends any existing parking entitlements and restrictions that currently apply to the sections of roads identified above.

VICARAGE HILL, PETHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow works to provide a new water connection to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Vicarage Hill, Petham, near Canterbury.

A closure is planned from Monday 5 June 2017 with estimated completion by 9 June 2017.

Vicarage Hill will be closed in the vicinity of number 2A, with no through access between the junctions with Capel Road and Town Road.

The alternative route is via Garlinge Green Road, Kenfield Road, Chartham Downs Road, Redhouse Lane, B2068 Stone Street and Town Road back to Vicarage Hill.

Access to the remainder of Vicarage Hill continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

YORK ROAD, CANTERBURY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow works to be carried out to lay phone ducting in the carriageway, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of York Road, Canterbury.

Off-peak closures are planned on Sunday 11 June 2017 and Sunday 18 June 2017.

Closures are from 09:00 hours through to 15:00 hours each day.

York Road will be closed in the vicinity of the junction with Wincheap, with no access to A28 Wincheap.

The alternative route to reach Wincheap is via Martyr's Field, St Mildred's Place and Victoria Road.

The closure is in conjunction with temporary traffic lights on A28 Wincheap, so some delays are possible.

Access to the remainder of York Road continues from Martyr's Field Road direction up to where the road is closed.

DOVER AREA

BAY HILL, ST MARGARET'S AT CLIFFE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow drainage improvement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily restrict traffic on sections of Bay Hill, St Margaret's at Cliffe, near Dover.

Works are planned from Monday 5 June 2017 for up to 4 weeks, to be carried out in 2 main phases, as follows

PHASE 1 – Monday 5 June for 1 week

Works from the junction with St Margaret's Road eastwards to the car park, with the use of temporary traffic lights

There will be No Entry to traffic from The Promenade direction to the remainder of Bay Hill

Traffic heading towards the village of St Margaret's at Cliffe will be diverted via St Margaret's Road

PHASE 2 – Monday 12 June for 3 weeks

Bay Hill fully closed between the junctions with Hotel Road and St Margaret's Road

The alternative route is via St Margaret's Road

Access to the remainder of Bay Hill continues from either direction up to where the road is closed, but there will be no through access during the works.

Due to the nature of these works, it is unlikely the road can be re-opened outside the working hours, but the road will be re-opened each weekend, late on Friday afternoons.

Access for residents affected by the closure will be maintained whenever it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons.

GORE LANE, EASTRY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow works to provide a new electricity supply to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Gore Lane, Eastry, near Sandwich.

A closure is planned from Monday 22 May 2017 with estimated completion by 28 May 2017.

Gore Lane will be closed in the vicinity of 'Ingleside', north of the junction with Selson Lane, with access from either direction up to where the road is closed, but no through access.

The alternative route is via Gore Lane, Mill Lane, High Street and Woodnesborough Lane.

Access to the remainder of Gore Lane continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

LYDDEN HILL RACE CIRCUIT (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

For the safety of the public during event weekends at Lydden Hill Race Circuit near Dover, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through

traffic on certain roads in the vicinity of Lydden Hill Circuit, Lydden, near Dover, as follows.

On those weekends when Lydden Hill is hosting events, several roads in Denton and Wootton will be closed to through traffic, as shown below.

~ There will be no access from the A260 Canterbury Road / The Street to Lydden Hill Race Circuit using any of the following roads ~

DENTON LANE and SHELVIN LANE closed at their junctions with A260 Canterbury Road

GEDDINGE LANE closed to the west of the entrance to AB Crush Panelcraft

SIDE HILLS (leading to CLINTS LANE) closed at the junction with A260 Canterbury Road

WOOTTON LANE closed at the junction with Stockham Lane

The above closures apply between 07:00 hours and 13:00 hours each day

SHELVIN LANE closed at the junction with the A2 Trunk Road between 15:30 hours and 18:00 hours each day.

The alternative route to Lydden Hill Race Circuit is via A260 The Street, Canterbury Road and A2 Trunk Road.

Managed access will be allowed for residents and visitors having a valid Permit

These restrictions apply on the following dates

· 27 & 28 May

· 5 & 6 August

The above restrictions may also be imposed for any other events that may subsequently be arranged, for up to one year.

WOODNESBOROUGH LANE, EASTRY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow drainage improvement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Woodnesborough Lane, Eastry, near Sandwich.

A closure is planned from Monday 5 June 2017 for an estimated period of up to 2 weeks.

Woodnesborough Lane will be closed at its northern end, between the junctions with Gore Lane and Peak Drive.

The alternative route is via Statenborough Lane and Sandwich road back to Woodnesborough Lane

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

Access for residents and visitors affected by the closure will be maintained whenever it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons.

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, DOVER DISTRICT) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) AMENDMENT No.48 ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of their powers and under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 44, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") proposes to make the following Order:

The effect of the named Order will introduce or amend waiting restrictions in the following lengths of road:

Albion Road, Deal. On the north side of the road, from the junction with The Marina in a westerly direction to its junction with Sandown Road.

Balfour Road, Walmer. On the north westerly side of the road, either side of the junction with Palmerston Avenue for a distance of 10m.

Palmerston Avenue, Walmer. On both sides of the road from the junction with Balfour Road for a distance of 12.8m in a north-westerly direction.

Lower Road, Temple Ewell. On both sides of the road from its junction with Alkham Road for a distance of 10.4m

St Bart's Road, Sandwich. On both sides of the road from its junction with Dover Road for a distance of 57.5m

Fordwich Place, Sandwich. On both sides of the road from its junction with St Bart's Road for a distance of 10m in a north-westerly direction.
