Notice is hereby given that Paul Montgomery of Strode Park Foundation, Herne, Herne Bay, Kent CT6 7NE has applied to Canterbury City Council for the Variation of Premises Licence.

Strode Park Foundation currently has a premises licence which allows events to take place Monday - Saturday with live music. We are seeking a variation to allow a one off event to take place on Sunday 27th August 2017 from 12.00 hrs to 21.00 hrs incorporating live music and attendance limited to 2,500 people, for the premises Strode Park Foundation situated at Herne, Herne Bay, Kent CT6 7NE.

Any person wishing to submit representations to my/our application must give notice in writing to the address shown above, giving in detail the grounds of objection by 08/06/2017.

The Council will not entertain representations where the writer requests that his identity remains anonymous. Copies of all representations will be included in the papers presented to the Licensing Panel and will therefore pass into the public domain. Representations must relate to one of the four Licensing Objectives: the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm. In the case of an application for a provisional statement, please note that representations will be restricted once a statement has been issued.
