THANET AREA

ALBERT TERRACE MEWS, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow works to provide a new gas supply to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Albert Terrace Mews, Margate.

A closure is planned from Monday 26 September 2017 for an estimated period of up to 3 days.

Albert Terrace Mews will be closed in the vicinity of the rear of 72 High Street, with access from Marine Gardens or Albert Terrace up to where the road is closed, but there will be no through access during these works.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

QUEX PARK EVENTS 2017 (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

In the interests of road safety during events being held at Quex Park, Birchington, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on B2050 Manston Road, Birchington, in the Thanet area.

The events are

- · East Kent Ploughing Match on 27 September 2017
- · Bonfire & Fireworks Night on 4 November 2017

B2050 MANSTON ROAD will be closed to through traffic between the junctions with Park Lane / Acol Hill and Margate Hill, with no through access, as and when barriers are placed on site.

The alternative route for through traffic during closures is via Acol Hill and Margate Hill

The closures do not apply to traffic exiting from the designated on-site car parking at Quex Park, which will be directed to turn right towards Acol Hill or left towards Margate Hill

Closures will be implemented for the following maximum times, to the extent deemed necessary according to traffic conditions.

- East Kent Ploughing Match on Wednesday 27
 September 2017, between 04:00 hours continuing through until 20:00 hours
 - Bonfire & Fireworks Night on Saturday 4
 November 2017, between 14:00 hours and 23:00
 hours, but for this event, it is likely closures will
 only be applied towards the latter stages of each
 event, when the main bulk of traffic is leaving the
 venue.
