

Highways

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

THANET AREA

A255 RAMSGATE ROAD, BROADSTAIRS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A255 Ramsgate Road, Broadstairs.

Overnight closures are planned from Tuesday 24 October 2017 for up to 3 nights, from 19:00 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

A255 Ramsgate Road will be closed between the junctions with Swinburne Avenue and West Cliff Road.

The alternative route is via A255 Ramsgate Road, Gladstone Road, Seafield Road, Osbourne Road, A255 The Broadway, High Street and Queens Road back to Ramsgate Road, and vice versa

Access for residents affected will be maintained whenever it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons.

Please note that Fairfield Road is also closed during these closures.

CLIFFS END ROAD, RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow junction modifications and the installation of drainage to be carried out for a new housing development, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Cliffs End Road, Cliffsend, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from Monday 23 October 2017, with estimated completion by 20 November 2017.

Cliffs End Road will be closed between the junctions with Foads Lane and Chapman Fields.

The alternative route is via Foads Lane, Foads Hill, Canterbury Road West, Lord of the Manor Interchange and Sandwich Road

Access to the remainder of Cliffs End Road continues from an eastern direction up to where the road is actually closed, but there will be no through access during these works.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

GROSVENOR HILL, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow an urgent sewer repair to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Grosvenor Hill, Margate.

A closure is planned from Monday 23 October 2017, with estimated completion by 3 November 2017.

Grosvenor Hill will be closed between the junctions with Park Place and Grosvenor Place.

The alternative route is via Park Place, A255 Grosvenor Gardens, High Street, Ramsgate Road, Queens Avenue and Grosvenor Place

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of Grosvenor Hill will be suspended between the junctions with Park Place and Grosvenor Place up to allow essential access / exit to where the road is closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

NASH ROAD, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2017

To allow crash remedial works to be carried out including signing, road markings and high-friction surfacing, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Nash Road, Margate.

A closure is planned from Monday 23 October 2017 with estimated completion by 27 October 2017.

Nash Road will be closed in the general vicinity of Nash Farm Shop.

Access to the remainder of Nash Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

The alternative routes are

Northbound via Star Lane, A254 Ramsgate Road and B2052 College Road

Southbound via B2052 Tivoli Road, Beatrice Road, A254 Ramsgate Road and Star Lane

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
