(PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Section 14(1), As Amended By The Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

Kent County Council has made an Order the effect of which is to temporarily close Public Footpath SD341 at the footbridge across the railway from the 12th October 2017.

The path will be closed for a maximum of six months

The path is closed because there is a likelihood of danger to users due to the bridge being deemed unsafe.

The alternative route is via Public Footpaths SD86, SD84 and SD338 or SD86, SD84, SD83 and SD340 then onto Public Right of Way 170 in the London Borough of Bromley.
