

THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT PROCEDURE) (ENGLAND) ORDER 2010

The following applications have been submitted for consideration by the Council:

Y17/1370/SH - 17 Sandgate High Street Sandgate Kent CT20 3BD - Change of use of ground floor and basement from retail (Class A1) to self-contained flat and associated alterations to the facade, together with installation of a rear dormer and other external alterations in connection with alterations to internal layout of existing upper floor flats, and installation of weatherboarding.

Y17/1363/SH - Hoad Farm Hoad Road Swingfield Kent CT18 8LP - Demolition of a barn/workshop and construction of a building for use as a games room and function room for use in conjunction with the existing holiday letting use.

Y17/1365/SH - Hoad Farm Hoad Road Swingfield Kent CT18 8LP - Listed building consent for the demolition of a barn/workshop within the curtilage of a listed building and construction of a replacement building (for ancillary leisure use).

Y17/1173/SH - 4B Prospect Road Hythe Kent CT21 5NN - Change of use and conversion of existing storage/studio building to self-contained first floor flat and ground floor studio/workshop, together with associated external alterations including erection of a single storey side extension and formation of a balcony.

Y17/1307/SH - Hillview The Street Newington Folkestone Kent - Erection of replacement rear extension with room in roof space.

Y17/1335/SH - Clifton Hotel 1 - 6 Clifton Gardens Folkestone Kent CT20 2EB - Advertisement consent for the display of No.1 internally illuminated fascia/wall sign.

Y17/1212/SH - Sleepers Cottage Dungeness Road Dungeness Romney Marsh Kent - Demolition and reconstruction of dwelling with a revised profile to the pitched roof and alteration to original footprint.

Y17/1325/SH - Port Lympne Aldington Road Lympne Kent CT21 4PD - Erection of a visitor lodge (holiday let).
