

THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT PROCEDURE) (ENGLAND) ORDER 2010

The following applications have been submitted for consideration by the Council:

Y17/0952/SH - Longage Manor Farm Longage Hill Lyminge Folkestone Kent - Erection of a farm shop (Class A1) and cafe (Class A3) building, and holiday let and guest house (Class C1) building following the demolition of two agricultural barns, together with the formation of a car park.

Y17/1396/SH - Quince Cottage High Street Brookland Romney Marsh Kent - Erection of two storey rear extension.

Y17/1397/SH - Quince Cottage High Street Brookland Romney Marsh Kent - Listed Building Consent for the erection of a two storey rear extension.

Y17/1552/SH - 151 Sandgate Road Folkestone Kent CT20 2DA - Erection of extension to existing single-storey rear extension to include demolition of existing rear wall, replacement of flat roof, creation of lightwell with internal alterations to layout of Flats 1 and 2 together with enclosure of front bin store facility.

Y17/1511/SH - The Sanctuary The Street Lympe Hythe Kent - Formation of opening in garden boundary wall and insertion of a pair of gates.

Y17/1533/SH - Howletts & Port Lympe Wild Animal Parks Port Lympe Aldington Road Lympe Hythe Kent - Change of use, conversion and extension of existing workshop to form two visitor accommodation units.

Y17/1553/SH - 151 Sandgate Road Folkestone Kent CT20 2DA - Listed Building Consent for the erection of extension to existing single-storey rear extension to include demolition of existing rear wall, replacement of flat roof, creation of lightwell with internal alterations to layout of Flats 1 and 2 and enclosure to existing bin store facility.
