Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

THANET AREA

CHATHAM STREET, RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow urgent electrical repair works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Chatham Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from Monday 8 January 2018 for an estimated period of up to 5 days.

Chatham Street will be closed between the junction with A255 Park Road / Boundary Road and the entrance to Asda car park.

The alternative route is via A255 Park Road and High Street or via A255 Boundary Road and Chatham Place.

Due to the nature of these works, the road will need to remain closed outside the working hours.

This Order comes into force from 8 January 2018 and remains in force until the works have been completed, with a maximum duration of 6 months.

GRAFTON ROAD, BROADSTAIRS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow gas mains replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Grafton Road, Broadstairs.

A closure is planned from Monday 8 January 2018, with estimated completion by 2 February 2018.

Grafton Road will be closed between the junctions with Camden Road and Afghan Road.

The alternative route is via Mockett Drive, Prince Charles Road, Fosters Avenue and Camden Road.

Due to the nature of the works, the road will need to remain closed outside the working hours.

This Order comes into force from 8 January 2018 and remains in force until the works have been completed, with a maximum duration of 6 months.

LANTHORNE ROAD, BROADSTAIRS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new foul sewer connection, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Lanthorne Road, Broadstairs.

A closure is planned from Monday 8 January 2018, with estimated completion by 26 January 2018.

Lanthorne Road will be closed in the vicinity of the junction with Callis Court Road.

Access to the remainder of Lanthorne Road continues from an eastern direction up to where the road is actually closed, but there will be no through access during these works.

The alternative routes for through traffic are via B2052 Stone Road, Crow Hill, Lindenthorpe Road and Callis Court Road or via Callis Court Road, Elmwood Avenue, B2052 North Foreland Hill and North Foreland Avenue.

Due to the nature of the works, the road will need to remain closed outside the working hours.
