Highways

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

ASHFORD AREA

A20 HYTHE ROAD & A2070 KENNINGTON ROAD. WILLESBOROUGH (10 MPH SPEED LIMIT) TEMPORARY **ORDER 2018**

For the safety of the public and workforce during Highways England works to resurface Willesborough Interchange, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to impose a temporary speed limit on A20 Hythe Road and A2070 Kennington Road, at Willesborough, Ashford

For the safety of the public and workforce, a temporary mandatory speed limit of 10 mph will be imposed on A20 Hythe Road and A2070 Kennington Road.

The 10 mph Speed Limit applies in conjunction with temporary traffic lights and a "Convoy System" to escort traffic through the roadworks, as and when the relevant signs are clearly displayed on site.

The Speed Limit applies in both directions on A20 Hythe Road between Willesborough Interchange eastwards to the roundabout junction with The Street, and on A2070 Kennington Road between Willesborough Interchange northwards to the junction with The Street

Restrictions apply during overnight works which are planned from Monday 15 January 2018 for an estimated period of up to weekday 10 nights, between 20:00 hours through until approximately 06:00 hours each night. This Order comes into force from 15 January 2018 and remains in force until the works have been completed, with a maximum duration of 6 months.

CHURCH STREET, WYE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) **TEMPORARY ORDER 2017**

To allow the safe use of a mobile crane to install a glass apex roof, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Church Street, Wye, near Ashford.

A closure is planned for Thursday 4 January 2018, between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours.

If the weather is unsuitable to allow the use of a mobile crane that day, the works will be deferred until the following Thursday, 11 January 2018.

Church Street will be closed in the vicinity of number 15 with access from either direction up to where the road is closed, but no through access.

The alternative route is via Bridge Street, Upper Bridge Street and High Street.

HART HILL, CHARING (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) **TEMPORARY ORDER 2018**

To allow safe access to the overhead phone cable network for a new customer service, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Hart Hill, Charing, near Ashford.

Off-peak closures are planned from Tuesday 2 January 2018 for up to 3 days, between 09:30 hours and approximately 15:30 hours each day. Hart Hill will be closed between the junctions with A20

Maidstone Road and Stone Stile Farm.

The alternative route is via A20 Maidstone Road, A252 Charing Hill, The Wynd and Bowl Road back to Hart Hill This Order comes into force from 2 January 2018 and remains in force until the works have been completed, with a maximum duration of 6 months.

MOCK LANE, GREAT CHART (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) **TEMPORARY ORDER 2018**

To allow drainage and construction works to be carried out in connection with a new development, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit Ashford.

A closure is planned from Tuesday 2 January 2018 for an estimated period of up to 5 weeks.

Mock Lane will be closed from the junction with Chilmington Green Road eastwards for approximately 500 metres.

The alternative route is via Chilmington Green Road, A28 Ashford Road / Great Chart Bypass, Tithe Barn Lane and Bucksford Lane.

Due to the extensive nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours. This Order comes into force from 2 January and remains in force until the works have been completed, with a maximum duration of 6 months.

THE STREET, BROOK (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) **TEMPORARY ORDER 2018**

To allow works to be carried out to provide new gas and electricity supplies, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of The Street, Brook, near Ashford.

A closure is planned from Monday 15 January 2018, with estimated completion by 19 January.

The Street will be closed in the vicinity of Woodpecker Cottages, with access from either direction up to where the road is actually closed, but no through access.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Spelders Hill, Naccolt Road, Oxenturn Road, Upper Bridge Street, Scotton Street, Coldharbour Lane and Amage Road back to The Street.

Due to the nature of the works, the road will need to

remain closed outside the working hours This Order comes into force from 15 January 2018 and

remains in force until the works have been completed, with a maximum duration of 6 months.

CANTERBURY AREA

CHURCH LANE, SEASALTER (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) **TEMPORARY ORDER 2018**

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new gas supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Church Lane, Seasalter, near Whitstable.

A closure is planned for Sunday 7 January 2018 for an estimated period of up to 1 day.

Church Lane will be closed in the vicinity of Orchard Cottage, with no through access between the junctions with Heritage Close and Faversham Road.

The alternative route for through traffic is via A2990 (Old) Thanet Way, B2205 Borstal Hill, Joy Lane and Faversham Road. Access to the remainder of Church Lane is mainly from

(Old) Thanet Way direction up to where the road is closed, but there will be no through access during these works

This Order comes into force from 7 January 2018 and remains in force until the works have been completed, with a maximum duration of 6 months.

CROMWELL ROAD WHITSTARLE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow cabling works to be carried out in connection with the installation of broadband, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Cromwell Road, Whitstable. A closure is planned from Monday 15 January 2018, with

estimated completion by 26 January 2018. Cromwell Road will be closed in the vicinity of numbers 114-118, north of the junction with Railway Avenue.

The alternative route is via Cromwell Road, B2205 Oxford Street, High Street, Sea Street (northbound only) and Harbour Street, and vice versa.

Access to the remainder of Cromwell Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, the road will need to remain closed outside the working hours

This Order comes into force from 15 January 2018 and remains in force until the works have been completed, with a maximum duration of 6 months.

MAYPOLE LANE, HOATH (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) **TEMPORARY ORDER 2018**

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new electricity supply, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Maypole Lane, Hoath, near Canterbury.

A closure is planned from Thursday 18 January 2018 for up to 2 days. Maypole Lane will be closed in the vicinity of the

property 'Melbury', with access continuing from either direction up to where the road is closed, but no through access.

The alternative route is via Maypole Road and the remainder of Maypole Lane.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

This Order comes into force from 18 January 2018 and remains in force until the works have been completed with a maximum duration of 6 months.

DOVER AREA

ACKHOLT ROAD & RATLING ROAD, AYLESHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow works to be carried out to update overhead electricity cabling, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Ackholt Road and Ratling Road, Aylesham, in the Dover area.

Daytime closures are planned from Wednesday 3 January 2018 for up to 3 days, between 07:30 hours and approximately 17:00 hours each day

Ackholt Road and Ratling Road will both be closed at the same time.

To allow works to be carried out to lay telecoms ducting in the carriageway, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Ratling Road, Aylesham, in the Dover area.
