- an increase of 10 pence per hour (or part of) on each parking tariff (up to a maximum tariff of £5.90)
- an increase of £10 (to £270) for 12 month off peak car park season tickets
- an increase of £10 (to £110) for monthly car park season tickets
- an increase of £25 (to £300) for 3 monthly car park season tickets
- an increase of £50 (to £550) for 6 monthly car park season tickets
- an increase of £50 (to £950) for 12 month car park season tickets
- an extension of charging days in the Castle Field car park, to Monday to Saturday (from Saturdays only)

In the town of West Malling.

High Street car park

- an increase of 10 pence per hour (or part of) on each existing parking tariff
- the introduction of a new £3.20 for 4 hour tariff

Rvarsh Lane car park

an increase of £25 (to £175) for 12 month car park season tickets

In the town of Borough Green

an increase of 10 pence on each parking tariff, up to a maximum tariff of £5.20

In the village of Blue Bell Hill

- an increase of 10 pence (to £2.50) for daily parking
- an increase of £1.60 (to £10) for weekly parking
- an increase of £3 (to £35) for monthly car park season tickets
- an increase of £15 (to £100) for 3 monthly car park season tickets
- an increase of £30 (to £180) for 6 monthly car park season tickets
- an increase of £35 (to £300) for 12 month car park season tickets
- Levbourne Lake and Havsden Country Parks

- an increase of 20p (to £1.20) to the "up to 4 hour" tariff, and an increase of £1 (to £4) to the "over 4 hour" tariff an increase of £10 (to £40) for 12 month car park season tickets
