Kent County Council has made an Order the effect of which is to temporarily close Byway AT254 between High Halden Road and TQ 887 382 the junction with Public Footpath AT166 from the 22nd February 2018

The path will be closed for a maximum of six months.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 SECTION 257

THE ASHFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL
(PUBLIC FOOTPATH AW327 (PART) & PUBLIC FOOTPATH AW328, SHADOXHURST)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018

The above Order made on 15th February 2018 under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 will divert the entire width of that length of public footpath numbered AW327 which commences at its connection with public footpath AW328 at NGR TQ 9712 3793 (point A) and runs north for 100.0 metres to its connection with Maytree Place at NGR TQ 9712 3803 (point B), between the points A-B on the Order plan; and the above Order will divert the entire width of that length of public footpath AW328 which commences at the aforementioned point A and runs north-east for 156.0 metres to its connection with Woodchurch Road at NGR TQ 9721 3806 (point C), between the points A-C on the Order plan. The Order provides a new length of public footpath numbered AW327 with a width of 2.0 metres which commences at the aforementioned point A and runs north-east through to north-north-west for 43.0 metres to NGR TQ 9711 3797 (point D) and a new length of public footpath numbered AW327 which commences at the aforementioned point B and runs south-west through to south for 30.0 metres to NGR TQ 9713 3800 (point E), between the points A-D and B-E on the Order plan. A new carriageway, which will be adopted under section 38 of the Highways Act 1980, will run between points D-F and will connect to point E. The Order also provides a new length of public footpath numbered AW328 with a width of 2.5 metres which commences at the aforementioned point A and runs east for 33.0 metres, then north-east through to north for 152.0 metres (a total length of 185.0 metres)

to its connection with Woodchurch Road at the aforementioned point C, between the points A-C on the Order plan.

All directions general, all distances approximate.
