

# THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, TONBRIDGE AND MALLING)(WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT 18) ORDER 2018



Notice is hereby given that Kent County Council has made the above Order, under Section 1, 2, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, the effect of which will be;

### In the Town of Tonbridge

Ward	Location	Change
Castle & Medway	High Street (north of Big Bridge) and west end of Lyons Crescent	Changes to parking bays, revised yellow lines and new P&D short-stay parking for shoppers.
Castle	Dry Hill Park Road	Replacement of parking bays with double yellow lines to maintain traffic movements
Castle	Stafford Road	Amendment to parking bays to create a disabled parking place
Higham	Hunt Road	New double yellow lines to prevent obstruction
Judd	Barden Park Road	Adjustments to parking bays and new double yellow lines across new access to allotments
Judd	Douglas Road	Adjustments to parking bays and new double yellow lines for new access to No.21
Judd	Douglas Road	Adjustments to parking bays and new double yellow lines for new access to No.72
Judd	Preston Road	New permit parking bays
Judd	Sussex Road	Adjustments to parking bays and new double yellow lines for new access to 82 Douglas Road
Medway	Hectorage Road	Adjustments to parking bays and new double yellow lines for new access to No.25

### In the Parish of Aylesford (Eccles)

Location	Change
Cork Street	The redefinition of disabled parking bay to meet current legislation

### In the Parish of Borough Green

Location	Change
Fairfield Road	Reduction of existing double yellow lines
High Street	Change of a limited waiting bay to disabled bay near the Chemist

### In the Parish of Burham

Location	Change
Court Road and New Court Road (Spur road)	New double yellow lines to prevent obstruction around junctions

### In the Parish of Wouldham

Location	Change
High Street (Knowle Road to Portland Road)	Extension of yellow line restrictions to ease traffic movements
High Street / Ferry Lane	Extension of yellow line restrictions to ease traffic movements, new enforceable disabled parking bays and bus stop.
High Street / Walter Burke Avenue	Reduction of existing double yellow lines to allow more on-street parking
Knowle Road / Cornwall Crescent	New yellow line restrictions and bus stop clearway
Knowle Road / Hall Road	Extension of yellow line restrictions to ease traffic movements
School Lane	Remove redundant School Keep Clear markings and alter yellow lines to increase parking
School Lane / High Street (Rochester Road)	Extension of yellow line restrictions to ease traffic movements and an enforceable disabled parking bay

### In the Parish of Addington

Location	Change
A20 London Road (east of Church Road)	Existing TRO does not correctly reflect restrictions and requires re-making to allow enforcement
A20 London Road (near Hernewell Farm)	Existing TRO does not correctly reflect restrictions and requires re-making to allow enforcement

### In the Parish of East Malling and Larkfield

Location	Change
New Hylthe Lane near Laburnum Drive	New weekday peak-time parking restrictions to prevent obstruction

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulations 1984, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
