RESTRICTIONS AND ON-STREET PARKING PLACES)
(AMENDMENT 31) ORDER 2020**



Notice is hereby given that Kent County Council intends to make the above Order, under Section 1, 2, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, the effect of which will be;

In the Parish of Aylesford

Location	Proposals
Pratling Street (near Beddow way)	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking
Firs Close	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking

In the Parish of Aylesford (Walderslade)

Location	Proposals
Taddington Wood Lane	New double yellow lines and bus stop clearways to prevent parking on bends, near junctions and at bus stops

In the Parish of Borough Green

Location	Proposals
Fairfield Road	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking
Griggs Way & Hunts Farm Close	New permit parking area and double yellow lines to prevent non-resident parking

In the Parish of Ditton

Location	Proposals
Brampton Field	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking
A20 London Road	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking and maintain traffic flow

In the Parish of East Malling and Larkfield

Ward	Location	Proposals
East Malling	Bondfield Road, Cobbett Close, Ruskin Close and Lister Close	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking on Bondfield Road and its junctions
East Malling	Temple Way, Carnation Crescent and Meridian Place	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking at junctions
Larkfield (North)	Brooklands Road	Changes and new double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking
Larkfield (North)	The Lakes	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking
Larkfield (North)	Chaucer Way	New double and single yellow lines to prevent obstructive daytime parking
Larkfield (North & South)	Papyrus Way	Changes to double yellow lines, new single yellow lines and an overnight parking ban on vehicles over 5 tonnes
Larkfield (South)	Woodpecker Road	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking
Larkfield (South)	Maple Close	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking

In the Parish of East Peckham

Location	Proposals
Medway Meadows, Hale Street and Old Road	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking

In the Town of Tonbridge

Ward	Location	Proposals
Cage Green	Rochester Road and The Ridgeway	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking
Castle	High Street	Change limited waiting bays to Pay & Display to improve parking space availability
Higham	Hunt Road	New double yellow lines and bus stop clearways to prevent obstructive parking
Judd	Lower Haysden Lane	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking
Medway	Lyons Crescent	Changes to parking bays – Change “limited waiting and permit parking bays” to separate “Pay & Display” and “permit parking” bays, and improved disabled parking facilities to improve parking space availability
Medway	Morley Road and Vale Road	New permit parking bays and new permit and phone payment parking bays to prevent long-stay parking by non-residents and deter storage of commercial vehicles on-street
Medway	Fairfield Crescent	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking
Medway	Somerhill Road and Gorham Drive	New permit parking restrictions and adjustments to double yellow lines
Medway	Swanmead Way	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking

In the Parish of West Malling

Location	Proposals
Old Parsonage Court	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking

In the Parish of Wrotham

Location	Proposals
Borough Green Road	New double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking
