Extension of the existing Allington Integrated Waste Management Facility

Publication of Statement of Community Consultation

FCC Environment (UK) Ltd is proposing to extend Allington Integrated Waste Management Facility by adding a new waste treatment line to complement the existing three-line Energy from Waste plant. This will increase the energy generating capacity of the facility to exceed 50MW, through the treatment of an additional c350,000 tonnes of residual waste each year. It is therefore considered a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project and FCC Environment (UK) Ltd will seek development consent under the Planning Act (2008).

The proposed scheme is an Environmental Impact Assessment development, and therefore the application will be accompanied by an Environmental Statement. In the interim, we will produce and consult on a Preliminary Environmental Information Report (PEIR). Consultation responses received will be considered carefully and may also inform the finalisation of the Environmental Statement.

We have published a Statement of Community Consultation (SoCC) which sets out how we will publicise and consult on the PEIR with the local community and how they can get involved.
