

Mission and Pastoral Measure 2011

The Church Commissioners have prepared a draft Pastoral Church Buildings Scheme providing for, amongst other things, the parish church of the parish of St Faith, Maidstone in the diocese of Canterbury to be declared closed for regular public worship and appropriated to use as a place of worship by The Lighthouse Church Maidstone and for the cost of the new place of worship situated on the site of Ringlestone Hall to be a first charge on the proceeds arising from the disposal of the St Faith's church building. A copy of the draft Scheme may be inspected at the church of St Faith, Maidstone.
