



**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS,  
BOROUGH OF SWALE)  
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET  
PARKING PLACES)  
(AMENDMENT No.16) ORDER 2020**

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL has made the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

The Order was made on 25th September 2020, will come into effect on 12th October 2020, and will Amend the Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2019 by installing double yellow lines

- (a) in Ham Road, Oare, on both sides of the road between points 14.5m north and 44 metres south of the centre of the eastern junction of Ham Road;
- (b) in the eastern section of Ham Road, Oare, on the north/northwest side of the road, for a distance of 36 metres from the junction with Ham Road and for a distance of 15 metres southwest from the centre of the junction of Alder Close, and on the south/southeast side of the road, from the junction with Ham Road to a point 9 metres northeast of the centre of Alder Close;
- (c) in Alder Close, Oare, on the southwestern side of the road, for a distance of 7 metres from the junction with Ham Road.

Any person wishing to question the validity of an Order or any of its provisions on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant Act or that a requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
