**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, DOVER DISTRICT) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS**

**AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (No. 83A) ORDER 2021**

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL intend to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

If made the effect of the Order will be to further amend Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2005 as follows :

**ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING PLACES**

It is proposed to install charging places for electric vehicles in the following locations

**DOVER**

- Folkestone Road (near Clarendon Road) 4 hours daytime waiting limit;
- Lewisham Road, River (former bus turning area) 4 hours daytime waiting limit
- Park Street (outside Police Station) 2 hours daytime waiting limit;
- Waterloo Crescent near Protea House) 4 hours daytime waiting limit;

**DEAL**

- Victoria Road (opposite 20-22) 2 hours daytime waiting limit
- The Strand (south of Admiralty Mews) 4 hours daytime waiting limit
- High Street (south of Ivy Place) 4 hours daytime waiting limit

**SANDWICH**

- New Street (outside 32 New Street) 2 hours daytime waiting limit
- Between 9am and 6pm any electric vehicle parking place may be used only by an electric vehicle which is actually being charged. During the daytime there is a restriction of either 2 hours or 4 hours (as indicated above)

Between 6pm and 9am the parking place may be used by an electric vehicle whether being charged or not.

Full details are contained in the draft Order which, together with a copy of any orders which will be amended by the proposed Order, drawings and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined on the Dover District Council web site [www.dover.gov.uk/parking](http://www.dover.gov.uk/parking) from Friday 16th April.
