

Notification of SSSIs

Notification: Swanscombe Peninsula Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI)

The site is located north and east of Swanscombe in Kent, stretching from the River Thames to the north to the A2 at Springhead to the south, and from Tiltman Avenue to the west to Manor Way to the east: national grid reference TQ605758.

Natural England hereby gives notice that on 11 March 2021

- The boundary of Bakers Hole SSSI has been enlarged under section 28C of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, to include more land that is considered to be of special interest. The enlarged site is now known as Swanscombe Peninsula SSSI.

The enlarged notification under section 28C takes effect immediately.
