

LICENSING ACT 2003

APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE

Notice is hereby given that **David Barnes** of **39 Tankerton Road, Whitstable CT5 2AF** has applied to Canterbury City Council for the **GRANT** of a **PREMISES LICENCE** under the above mentioned legislation.

Copies of all representations will be included in the papers presented to the Licensing Panel and will therefore pass into the public domain. Representations must relate to one of the four Licensing Objectives: the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm.
