

Section 17 Licensing Act 2003

Application for a new Premises Licence

Notice is hereby given that **Charlotte's in the Pantiles Ltd** has applied to the **Tunbridge Wells Borough Council** c/o The Sevenoaks Licensing Partnership on 22nd April 2021 for a new premises licence for **Charlotte's, 26-28, The Pantiles, Tunbridge Wells, TN2 5TN**

The proposed application is to permit :

- 1. the provision of late night refreshment for the provision of hot food and hot beverages until 12 midnight daily and on New Year's Eve until 02.00**
- 2. the sale by retail of alcohol until 12 midnight daily and on New Year's Eve until 02.00**

The application can be viewed at the offices of the Licensing Authority, Tunbridge Wells Borough Council, The Town Hall, Tunbridge Wells, Kent TN1 1RS between 9.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m, Monday to Friday (except public holidays) or www.sevenoaks.gov.uk. Any person wishing to make representations concerning this application should do so in writing to the above local authority giving in detail stating the grounds of objection and within 28 consecutive days of the submission of the application that is by no later than 20 th May 2021. The Licensing Authority must receive representations by the date given above. Representations must relate to one or more of the four licensing objectives: THE PREVENTION OF CRIME AND DISORDER, PUBLIC SAFETY, THE PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE, OR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN FROM HARM.

It is an offence, under section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003, to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in or in connection with an application for premises licence and the maximum fine is an unlimited fine.
