

## **Application for Variation of a Premises Licence**

Any person who wishes to make a representation in relation to this application must give notice in writing of his/her representation by **11th October 2020 (28 days the day after the application is received by the licensing department)** stating the grounds for making said representation to: **Maidstone Borough Council, Maidstone House, King Street, Maidstone, Kent ME15 6JQ between 9.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m – Monday to Friday (except public holidays) or [www.sevenoaks.gov.uk](http://www.sevenoaks.gov.uk)**

The public register where applications are available to be viewed by members of the public can be accessed online by visiting at **<http://pa.sevenoaks.gov.uk/online-licensing>** and following the link to the public register.

The Licensing Authority must receive representations by the date given above. Representations must relate to one or more of the four licensing objectives: THE PREVENTION OF CRIME AND DISORDER, PUBLIC SAFETY, THE PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE, OR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN FROM HARM.

It is an offence, under section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003, to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in or in connection with an application for premises licence and the maximum fine is an unlimited fine.
