The paths are closed because of demolition works to the adjacent wall.

The alternative route is via St Stephens Hill, Downs Road, Long Meadow Way, Bawden Close, Hunton Gardens and Public Footpath CC16 which will be signed for the duration of the closure.

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT FOR THE COUNTY OF KENT

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL

(PUBLIC FOOTPATH CH34 (PART) AT HERNE & BROOMFIELD) (DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2021)

The above Order was made on 16th September 2021 under section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. If confirmed, it will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by deleting the full width and length of that part of public footpath numbered CH34 which commences at NGR TR 1759 6466 (Point A) and runs in a south-easterly direction for 179 metres to NGR TR 1770 6453 (Point B). As shown by the bold purple line on the Order plan between the points A-B, and adding a length of public footpath numbered CH34 with a width of 1.5 metres, which commences at NGR TR 1760 6467 (Point C) and runs in a south-easterly direction for 177 metres to the aforementioned Point B. As shown by the black broken line on the Order plan between the points C-B.

All distances are approximate, all directions are general.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2021

The above Order made on 16th September 2021 under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act and will divert the entire width of that length of public footpath numbered ER54 which commences at NGR TR 3057 4473 (Point A on the order plan) and runs in an east-north-easterly direction for 428 metres to NGR TR 3099 4480 (Point B). As shown by a solid black line between Points A and B on the order plan and will add a new length of public footpath numbered ER54 with a width of 2.0 metres which commences at the aforementioned Point A and runs in a north-easterly direction for 86 metres to NGR TR 3064 4478 (Point C) and in an easterly direction for 38 metres to NGR TR 3068 4478 (Point D) continuing in a south-easterly direction for 98 metres to NGR TR 3077 4475 (Point E) then in a south-south-easterly direction for 6 metres to NGR TR 3077 4474 (Point F) and continuing in an east-north-easterly direction for 111 metres to NGR TR 3088 4477 (Point G) and then a north-easterly direction for 32 metres to NGR TR 3090 4480 (Point H) and then a south-easterly direction for 21 metres to NGR TR 3092 4478 (Point I) and then in an east-northeasterly direction for 70 metres to aforementioned Point B.

The Secretary of State for Transport has directed that the Order made by Kent County Council on the 03 August 2018, and was subsequently extended until the 04 November 2021, the effect of which was to prohibit all traffic from Public Footpaths HE301 and HE302A has been extended for a further 6 months, until the 04 May 2022

Public Footpath HE301 is closed between the A20 and Bulls Lane and Public Footpath HE302A is closed from the M20 to its junction with Public Footpath HE301

The alternative route is via the A20.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2021

On 11 October 2021 Sevenoaks District Council confirmed the above Order under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

The effect of the Order, as confirmed, is to divert the entire width of that length of public footpath numbered SR41 which commences on an unaffected length of public footpath SR41 at NGR TQ 4972 6106 (point A) and runs north-east for 45 metres to NGR TQ 4976 6108 (point B) and then turns to run south-east for 10 metres to its connection with another unaffected length of public footpath SR41 at NGR TQ 4977 6108 (point C), between the points A-B-C on the Order plan, and is to add a new length of public footpath numbered SR41 which commences at the aforementioned point A and continues to run south of the field boundary heading east north-east for 47 metres to the aforementioned point C, between the points A-C on the Order plan.

All directions general, all distances approximate.

The Order came into force on 11 October 2021, the date upon which the Kent County Council, on behalf of Sevenoaks District Council certified that the terms of article 2 of the Order had been complied with, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.

The Secretary of State for Transport has directed that the Order made by Kent County Council on the 1 May 2018, and subsequently extended until the 1st November 2021, the effect of which was to prohibit all traffic from Public Footpath ZB48 has been extended for a further 13 months, until the 1st December 2022

The path is closed between Rushenden Road and the south west corner of the former Klondyke Industrial site.

The alternative route is along Rushenden Road and First Avenue and will be signed for the duration of the closure.
