

## Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

### ASHFORD AREA

#### A251 FAVERSHAM ROAD, CHALLOCK, ASHFORD (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new telecoms connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A251 Faversham Road, Challock, near Ashford.

A closure is currently planned for Sunday 7 November 2021 between 07:00 hours and approximately 16:00 hours.

A251 Faversham Road will be closed between the 2 eastern junctions with Pested Lane, to the actual extent shown on site.

~ There will be no direct access between Ashford and Faversham during these works ~

The alternative route for all through traffic is via A251 Ashford Road, A2 Canterbury Road, London Road, Brenley Corner, Boughton Bypass, Dover Road, A2050 Harbledown Bypass, London Road Roundabout, Rheims Way, St Peter's Roundabout, A28 Wincheap Green, Wincheap, Thanington Road, Ashford Road, Canterbury Road, A252 Maidstone Road, The Street and Canterbury Road back to A2521 Faversham Road.

The above route applies in reverse for northbound traffic.

Local access to the remainder of the A251 continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

#### APPLEDORE ROAD, KENARDINGTON & KENARDINGTON ROAD, APPLEDORE. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

Because of Openreach pole testing works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Appledore Road, Kenardington and Kenardington Road, Appledore, on or after 18th November 2021 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Woodlands and Gusbourne Estate Vineyard, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Appledore Road, B2067 Warehorne Road, Kenardington Road, Bench Hill, Woodchurch Road and vice versa.

#### ASHFORD & DISTRICT 10 & 5 MILE RUN (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

Ashford & District 10 & 5 Mile Run 31 October 2021  
To allow the Ashford & District 10 & 5 Mile Run to take place on and near the highway, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Sandyhurst Lane and Lenacre Street near Ashford.

Closures are planned for Sunday 31 October 2021 starting from 10:00 hours onwards, with roads re-opened as soon as it is safe to do so, and by no later 12:30 hours.

Roads will be closed as shown below, to the extent indicated at any time by signs and barriers on site.

SANDYHURST LANE – closed between A251 Faversham Road and Sandyacres Sports Club LENACRE STREET – closed for its entire length

The alternative route for through traffic is via A251 Faversham Road, Trinity Road, Junction 9 Interchange, Fougeres Way, Drivers Roundabout and A20 Maidstone Road.

Nothing in the Order will apply to:

- Any Vehicle being used for Ambulance purposes, Coastguard/RNLI, Fire Brigade or Police services.
- Anything done by a Statutory Undertaker vehicle in connection with an emergency repair.
- Anything done with the permission or at the direction of Event Organisers or a Police Constable in Uniform.

#### BETHERSDEN ROAD, SMARDEN, ASHFORD (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new electricity supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bethersden Road, Smarden, in the Ashford area.

A closure is currently planned for Monday 1 November 2021, with estimated completion by 5 November 2021.

Bethersden Road will be closed in the general vicinity of Langley Oast, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Smarden Road, Bull Lane, A28 Ashford Road, A262 Biddenden Road, Tenterden Road, North Street, Headcorn Road, Smarden Road, The Cut and Biddenden Road back to Bethersden Road, and vice versa.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

#### CROWBRIDGE ROAD, ASHFORD. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Crowbridge Road,

Ashford, on or after 15th November 2021, between the hours of 20:00 and 05:00, with estimated completion by 20th November 2021.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Gladstone Road and The Boulevard to the actual extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The works are being carried out under two phases, as detailed below.

##### Phase 1

Crowbridge Road will be closed between the junctions with Gladstone Road and Crowbridge Link, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Gladstone Road, Mead Road, Canterbury Road and Crowbridge Link.

##### Phase 2

Crowbridge Road will be closed between the junctions with Crowbridge Link and The Boulevard, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Crowbridge Link, Canterbury Road, Monument Way and The Boulevard.

#### SUSANS HILL, WOODCHURCH. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

Because of Southern Water works to replace defective tarmac, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Susans Hill, Woodchurch, on or after 19th November 2021 for up to 4 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside Rose Cottage.

The alternative route is via Susans Hill, Haycross Lane, B2067 Brook Street, Front Road and vice versa.

#### THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, BOROUGH OF ASHFORD) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS & STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT 8) ORDER 2020

##### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Kent County Council, acting as the Local Traffic Authority, in exercise of its powers and under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 44, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

The effect of the made Order will be to introduce or amend existing waiting restrictions (DYL means double yellow lines "no waiting at any time" restrictions) in the following length of roads:-

##### Roads in Ashford in the Borough of Ashford

**BARROW HILL** - To place a 24 hour Loading Bay at a point 12.5 metres south west of the junction with New Street for a distance of 10.5 metres in a south westerly direction. **GRAVEL WALK – DYL** – Change to both sides for its entire length.

The Order was made on 28 October 2021 and its provisions will come into effect on 29 October 2021.

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.

### CANTERBURY AREA

#### B2205 CANTERBURY ROAD, WHITSTABLE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of B2205 Canterbury Road, Whitstable, on or after 4th November 2021 for up to 8 nights between the hours of 19:30 and 05:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Joy Lane and Belmont Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic (excluding HGVs) is via B2205 Oxford Street, High Street, Horsebridge Road, Sea Street, Harbour Street, Tower Parade, Tankerton Road, Bennells Avenue, Herne Bay Road, Chestfield Road, A2990 Thanet Way, Clapham Hill, Borstal Hill and Canterbury Road.

The alternative route for HGVs is via B2205 Canterbury Road, Oxford Street, Tower Parade, Tankerton Road, Bennells Avenue, Herne Bay Road, St Johns Road, Whitstable Road, Sea Street, Greenhill Bridge Road, A2990 Thanet Way and B2205 Borstal Hill.

#### BEKESBOURNE LANE, CANTERBURY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow replacement works to be carried out Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Bekesbourne Lane, Canterbury, on or after 15th November 2021 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed at the junction with A257 Littlebourne Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Bekesbourne Lane, A257 Littlebourne Road and vice versa.

#### HAM SHADES LANE, WHITSTABLE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow vegetation works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on / part of Ham Shades Lane, Whitstable, on or after 15th November 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of the rail bridge, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Ham Shades Lane, Church Street, Castle Road, Queens Road and vice versa.

#### MONASTERY STREET, CANTERBURY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow water main connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Monastery Street, Canterbury, on or after 15th November 2021 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of 13A, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Monastery Street, A257 Longport, Lower Chantry Lane, St George's Place, St George's Roundabout, A28 Lower Bridge Street, Broad Street, Lady Wootton's Green and vice versa.

#### PEAFIELD WOOD ROAD, BARHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2021

To allow water main connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Peafield Wood Road, Barham, on or after 18th November 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Fishers Lane and Palmstead Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Fishers Lane, South Lodge Hill, Palmstead Road and vice versa.

### CANTERBURY AND DOVER AREAS

#### GROVE ROAD, PRESTON & WICKHAMBREAUX. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow for pole testing works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Grove Road, Preston and Wickhambreaux, on or after 15th November 2021 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Stourmouth Road and Grove Ferry Road.

The alternative route is via Stourmouth Road, Preston Road, The Street, Plucks Gutter, Gore Street, A253 Ramsgate Road, A28 Canterbury Road / Island Road, Grove Ferry Hill and Grove Ferry Road (note 18 T weight limit on Grove Ferry Bridge) and vice versa.

For any vehicles over 18T in weight, the route is via Preston Road, Preston Hill, A257 High Street, Canterbury Road, Wingham Lane, The Street (Ickham), Wickham Lane and Wickham Road back to Grove Road.

### DARTFORD AREA

#### HIGH STREET & HYTHE STREET, DARTFORD. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPEND ONE-WAY) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow Dartford town centre regeneration works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on High Street and suspend the One-Way Order on Hythe Street, Dartford, on or after 1st November 2021 for up to 18 months or until the works have been completed.

High Street will be closed both sides, from its junction with Spital Street and Hythe Street in an easterly direction to its junction with Bullace Lane, except for construction traffic.

Suspend the One-Way restriction on Hythe Street between its junction with the works compound (access situated approximately 15 metres south of its junction

with Suffolk Road) and High Street, allowing for 2-way traffic by authorised Vehicles being used in connection with the said works only. Stop & Go will be used for the vehicle movements.

#### RED STREET, SOUTHFLEET. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

Because of Openreach works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Red Street, Southfleet, on or after 3rd November 2021 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside Proctors.

The alternative route is via Red Street, New Barn Road, Station Road, Dale Road and vice versa.

#### SHIREHALL ROAD, HAWLEY. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

Because of Openreach works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Shirehall Road, Hawley, on or after 5th November 2021 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between numbers 44 and 118.

The alternative route is via Ash Road, Mill Road, Cross Road, Hawley Road, Shirehall Road and vice versa.

### DOVER AREA

#### BEACON LANE, WOODNESBOROUGH, SANDWICH (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow telecoms ducting and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Beacon Lane, Woodnesborough, near Sandwich.

An off-peak closure is planned for Friday 5 November 2021 between 09:30 hours and approximately 15:30 hours.

Beacon Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of the property Lowlands, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Foxborough Hill and Drainless Road.

#### MEGGETT LANE, ALKHAM. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

Because of new water connection works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Meggett Lane, Alkham, on or after 15th November 2021 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the vicinity of South Alkham Farm.

The alternative route is via Alkham Valley Road, Hogbrook Hill Lane, Meggett Lane and vice versa.

#### MILL LANE, SHEPHERDSWELL. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

Because of UKPN electrical cabling works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Mill Lane, Shepherdswell, on or after 16th November 2021 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside numbers 1 to 29.

The alternative route is via Mill Lane, Long Lane, Eythorne Road, Church Hill and vice versa.

#### SUTTON ROAD, RIPPLE, DEAL (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to install a safety barrier, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Sutton Road, Ripple, Deal.

Daytime closures are planned for Thursday 4 November 2021 for up to 3 days, between 08:00 hours and approximately 19:00 hours each day.

Sutton Road will be closed in the general vicinity of the junction with Beacon Hill, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Beacon Hill, Willow Road, Northbourne Road, Mongeham Road, Sutton Road.

#### UPPER ROAD, GUSTON, DOVER (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new fibre connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Upper Road, Guston, Dover.

Overnight closures are planned from 1 November 2021 for up to 4 nights from 19:00 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

Upper Road will be closed between Bleriot Memorial and the bridge over A2 Jubilee Way, to the actual extent shown on site.
