

# Highways

## Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

To allow pole testing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Lower Road, Buckland, on or after 1st November 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of The Old Rectory, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Lower Road, Lower Norton Lane, A2 London Road, Four Oaks Road and vice versa.

### TONBRIDGE & MALLING AREA

#### A227 BOROUGH GREEN ROAD, WROTHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow road crossing works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of A227 Borough Green Road, Wrotham, on or after 21st November 2021 & 28th November 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of Potter Mead, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via A227 Borough Green Road, Wrotham Bypass, A20 London Road, Wrotham Heath Roundabout, A25 Maidstone Road, Station Road, High Street, Western Road, Wrotham Road and vice versa.

#### BRANBRIDGES ROAD, EAST PECKHAM. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

Because of Openreach works to replace a pole on Branbridges Road, outside number 49, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Branbridges Road, East Peckham, on or after 1st November 2021 for up to 3 days between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30 each day.

The road will be closed in the vicinity of number 49.

The alternative route is via Branbridges Road, Hale Street, Maidstone Road, A228 Maidstone Road Roundabout/ Hale Street By Pass/ Branbridges Ind Est Roundabout and vice versa.

#### BROADWATER ROAD, WEST MALLING. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

Because of Openreach overhead cabling works, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Broadwater Road, West Malling, on or after 5th November 2021 for up to 6 hours or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 59.

The alternative route is via Broadwater Road, Pikey Lane, The Heath, Wateringbury Road, Chapel Street, High Street, Mill Street, Clare Lane and vice versa.

#### LAMBERTS YARD, TONBRIDGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2021

To allow ducting works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Lamberts Yard, Tonbridge, on or after 4th November 2021 for up to 5 days between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 42, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

There is no alternative route for this closure, due to the road being a dead-end.

#### LEIGH ROAD, HILDENBOROUGH (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow examination works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Leigh Road, Hildenborough,

on or after 18th November 2021 for up to 1 night between the hours of 20:00 and 06:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of the rail bridge, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Leigh Road, Powder Mill Lane, Hildenborough Road, Stocks Green Road, Tonbridge Bypass and vice versa.

#### LONG MILL LANE, PLATT. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

Because of Openreach works to reset a manhole frame and cover, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Long Mill Lane, Platt, on or after 4th November 2021 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside Amberley.

The alternative route is via Long Mill Lane, A25 Maidstone Road, Grange Road and vice versa.

#### MILL LANE, HILDENBOROUGH. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

Because of UKPN electrical connection works, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Mill Lane, Hildenborough, on or after 1st November 2021 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside Westover.

The alternative route is via Mill Lane, Bank Lane, B245 London Road and vice versa.

#### MOTE ROAD, IVY HATCH (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow pole testing works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Mote Road, Ivy Hatch, on or after 19th November 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30 or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed at the junction with High Cross Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Mote Road, Hildenborough Road, A227 Tonbridge Road, Stumble Hill, High Cross Road and vice versa.

#### REGENT WAY, KINGS HILL (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow frame and cover replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Regent Way, Kings Hill, on or after 15th November 2021 for up to 2 days between the hours of 09:00 and 18:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed at the junction with Ruby Walk, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Regent Way, Holly Way, Discovery Drive, Bovarde Avenue, Tower View and vice versa.

#### THE CRESCENT, TONBRIDGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow pole installation works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of The Crescent, Tonbridge, on or after 2nd November 2021 for up to 3 days between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from outside number 4 to outside number 6, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via The Crescent, Havelock Road, Houselands Road and vice versa.

#### THE STREET, PLAXTOL (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow pole testing works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of The Street, Plaxtol, on or after 18th November 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of Limekiln, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via The Street, School Lane, Hamptons Road, Dunks Green Road, Long Mill Lane and vice versa.

#### VALE ROAD, TONBRIDGE. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & CYCLISTS AND SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY ORDER) TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To enable carriageway resurfacing works to be completed, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic Vale Road, Tonbridge, on or after 18th November 2021 for up to 10 weeknights or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from B2260 High Street to Sovereign Way.

The Cyclelane will also be closed and the one-way order on part of Vale Road will be suspended to allow for access.

The alternative route is via A26 Vale Rise/ Woodgate Way, A2014 Pembury Road, B2260 Quarry Hill Road/ Railway Approach and vice versa.

### TUNBRIDGE WELLS AREA

#### A26 ST JOHN'S ROAD, TUNBRIDGE WELLS (SUSPENSION OF CYCLE LANE) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

Because of Openreach works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily suspend the cycle lane on part of A26 St John's Road, Tunbridge Wells, on or after 1st November 2021 for up to 3 nights between 19.00hrs and 05.00hrs or until the works have been completed.

The cycle lane will be closed between numbers 71 and 83.

#### A264 PEMBURY ROAD, SANDROCK ROAD & HALLS HOLE ROAD, TUNBRIDGE WELLS (PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, NO RIGHT & LEFT TURNS) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

For the safety of the public whilst an event is being held at Dunorlan Park, Kent County Council has made an Order restrict traffic as per the schedule below.

##### SCHEDULE

No right turn from Sandrock Road into A264 Pembury Road

No right turn from A264 Pembury Road into Sandrock Road

No left turn from A264 Pembury Road into Sandrock Road

Halls Hole Road closed between Bayhall Road and Cornford Lane, diversion via Bayhall Road, Pembury Road and Halls Hole Road.

A264 Pembury Road closed at the junction with Sandhurst Road from 19.30hrs for approximately 20 minutes to allow crowds to disperse

A264 Pembury Road closed approximately 50m south of junction with Sandrock Road from 19.30hrs for approximately 20 minutes to allow crowds to disperse  
This Order takes effect on or after 6 November 2021 for a period of up to 1 evening between 17.00hrs and 21.00hrs.

#### BARDEN ROAD, SPELDHURST (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

Because of South East Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Barden Road, Speldhurst, on or after 1st November 2021 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside Speldhurst Bank.

The alternative route is via Barden Road, B2176 Penshurst Road/Bidborough Ridge, A26 London Road/ St Johns Road, Speldhurst Road, Etherington Hill, Speldhurst Hill and vice versa.

#### GATE FARM ROAD, BIDBOROUGH (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

Because of South East Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Gate Farm Road, Bidborough, on or after 1st November 2021 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed to the side of Haysden Herb and Honey Farm.

The alternative route is via Gate Farm Road, Hayesden Lane, B2176 Penshurst Road/Bidborough Ridge and vice versa.

#### STONE COURT LANE, PEMBURY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

Because of South East Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Stone Court Lane, Pembury, on or after 1st November 2021 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between numbers 10 and 12.

There is no alternative route but access will be maintained when safe to do so.

#### THE GREEN, MATFIELD (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

Because of South East Water works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of The Green, Matfield, on or after 2nd November 2021 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside The White House.

The alternative route is via The Green, B2160 Maidstone Road and vice versa.

#### TURNDEN ROAD, CRANBROOK. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

Because of South East Water, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Turnden Road, Cranbrook, on or after 2nd November 2021 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside Courtlands Farm.

The alternative route is via Turnden Road, A229 Hartley Road, B2085 Glassenbury Road and vice versa.
