

LICENSING ACT 2003 NOTICE OF
APPLICATION TO VARY A PREMISES
LICENCE UNDER SECTION 34

Notice is hereby given that on the 21st October 2021 **The Craft Union Pub Company** Ltd applied to Medway and Gravesham Licensing Partnership for a variation of the Premises Licence in respect of premises **The Somerset Arms**, 10 Darnley Road, Gravesend DA11 0RU. The proposed variation is:- 1. To amend the hours for films, indoor sporting events, live music, recorded music, performance of dance and sale of alcohol on Fridays and Saturdays only to 1000 to 0200. 2. To permit live music from 1000 to 0200 on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve. 3. To amend the opening hours on Fridays and Saturdays only to 1000 to 0230. 4. To amend the hours for late night refreshment on Fridays and Saturdays only to 2300 to 0200.
