

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

Because of works to replace a decayed pole, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Gilford Road, Deal, on or after 12th May 2022 for up to 1 day, between 09:30 hours and 15:30 hours or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between numbers 27 and 31, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for Westbound traffic is via Gilford Road, Park Avenue, A258 London Road/Queen Street/Broad Street/Beach Street/Prince Of Wales Terrace/Deal Castle Road and Victoria Road.

The alternative route for Eastbound traffic is via Gilford Road, Victoria Road, Ranelagh Road, A258 Prince Of Wales Park Avenue/Beach Street/Broad Street/Queen Street/London Road and Park Avenue.

LODGE LEES ROAD, DENTON. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of new service connection works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Lodge Lees Road, Denton, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 5 days, between 09:00 hours and 13:00 hours or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the vicinity of Lodge Lees Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Lodge Lees Road, Agester Lane, Walderchain and vice versa.

MIDDLE STREET, DEAL. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of works to replace a stop tap, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Middle Street, Deal, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the vicinity of number 77, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Oak Street, High Street, Market Street, Middle Street and vice versa.

SELSON LANE, EASTRY. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of new utility connection works, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Selson Lane, Eastry, on or after 27th April 2022 for up to 2 days, between 09:30 hours and 15:30 hours or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed for the entire length.

The alternative route is via Gore Lane, Foxborough Hill, Drainless Road, Hammill Road and vice versa.

WARE ROAD, WARE. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of drainage works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Ware Road, Ware, on or after 12th May 2022 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between School House and Lower Ware Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Ware Road, Wass Drove and vice versa.

(VARIOUS ROADS, DOVER DISTRICT) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO.96) ORDER 2022

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 35(1), 44, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, propose to make the following order:-

The effect of the Order will be to introduce new or to extend or amend existing waiting restrictions in the following lengths of road (in this part of the notice DYL means waiting to be prohibited at all times by double yellow lines at the times prescribed below).

Roads in Eythorne in the District of Dover

BARVILLE ROAD – DYL – On both sides from its junction with Wigmore Lane to a point 77 metres east of its junction with Pike Road. **CHAPLE HILL – DYL** – (1) On the west side from its junction with Flax Court Lane for a distance of 8.1 metres in a northerly direction. (2) On the east side from its junction with Sandwich Road for a distance of 67.4 metres in a northerly direction. **COLDRED ROAD** – On the west side from its junction with Flax Court Lane a Bus Stop Clearway for a distance of 20 metres. **MILYARD WAY – DYL** – On both sides from its junction with Wigmore Lane for a distance of 31 metres in a north westerly direction. **PIKE ROAD – DYL** – On both sides from its junction with Barville Road for a distance of 322 metres in a north easterly direction. **SANDWICH ROAD – DYL** – (1) On the west side from its junction with Chapel Hill for a distance of 25.5 metres

in a northerly direction. (2) On the east side from its junction with The Street for a distance of 50.2 metres in a northerly direction. **WIGMORE LANE – DYL** – On both sides from a point 8 metres west of the junction with Millyard Way to its junction with Barville Road.

FOLKESTONE & HYTHE AREA

A260 HILL ROAD, A260 DOVER ROAD, & DOVER ROAD (C652), FOLKESTONE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on A260 Hill Road, part of A260 Dover Road, and part of Dover Road (C652), Folkestone, on or after 13th May 2022 for up to 8 working nights, between 20:00 hours and 05:00 hours, or until the works have been completed.

The roads will be closed as detailed below:

A260 Hill Road will be closed for the entire length.

A260 Dover Road will be closed for a distance approximately 30 metres south of the junction with A260 Hill Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Dover Road (C652) will be closed for a distance approximately 30 metres north of the junction with A260 Hill Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any Eastbound traffic is via A260 Hill Road Roundabout, A260 Hill Road Dual Carriageway, A259 Canterbury Road, A259 Black Bull Road, A2033 Foord Road, A2033 New Street, A2033 Bradstone Road, A2033 Dover Road, and A260 Dover Road.

The alternative route for any Westbound traffic is via A260 Dover Road, A260 Southern Way, A260 The Tram Road, A2033 Harbour Street, A2033 Tontine Street, A2033 Dover Road, A2033 Grace Hill, A2033 Foord Road, A259 Radnor Park Road, A259 Pavilion Road, A259 Black Bull Road, A259 Canterbury Road, A260 Hill Road Dual Carriageway, and A260 Hill Road Roundabout.

A2033 GRACE HILL, A2033 DOVER ROAD, & A2033 TONTINE STREET, FOLKESTONE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, SUSPEND ONE-WAY & NO LEFT TURN) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow street light column replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Grace Hill, Folkestone, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 1 night, between 22:00 hours and 05:00 hours, or until the works have been completed. The left hand turn out of A2033 Tontine Street onto A2033 Dover Road will be closed and traffic will need to be filtered into one lane. The one-way Order on A2033 Grace Hill, A2033 Dover Road, & A2033 Tontine Street will be suspended to allow access.

A2033 Grace Hill will be closed between Rendezvous Street and the library, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via;

Diversion route A (For those wanting to go round past the Library on A2033 Grace Hill): A2033 Grace Hill, A2033 New Street, A2033 Bradstone Road, A2033 Dover Road, A260 Dover Road, A260 Hill Road, A260 Hill Road Roundabout, A260 Hill Road Dual Carriageway, A259 Canterbury Road, A259 Black Bull Road, A259 Pavilion Road, A259 Radnor Park Road, A259 Cheriton Road, A2034 Cheriton Road, A2033 Middleburg Square, and Foresters Way.

Diversion route B (For those wanting to join A2033 Dover Road from A2033 Tontine Street, travelling Westbound): A2033 Tontine Street, A2033 Dover Road, A260 Dover Road, A260 Hill Road, A260 Hill Road Roundabout, A260 Hill Road Dual Carriageway, A259 Canterbury Road, A259 Black Bull Road, A259 Pavilion Road, A259 Radnor Park Road, A259 Cheriton Road, A2034 Cheriton Road, A2033 Middleburg Square, and Foresters Way.

B2075 ROMNEY ROAD & LYDD AIRPORT APPROACH ROAD, LYDD. (40MPH SPEED LIMIT & NO WAITING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

For the safety of the public whilst events are being held at Lydd Airport, Kent County Council has made

an Order for traffic on B2075 Romney Road, Lydd to be restricted to 40mph between A259 Lydd Road and the 30mph speed limit. There will be no waiting for traffic on Lydd Airport Approach Road, Lydd, between B2075 Romney Road and the airport car park.

Connected Festival - from 10:00 hours on 30th April 2022 to 02:00 hours on 1st May 2022.

Dream Valley - from 09:00 hours on 28th May 2022 to 23:00 hours on 29th May 2022.

BEACH ROAD & WOODLAND WAY, DYMCHURCH. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of gas mains replacement works, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on Beach Road and Woodland Way, Dymchurch, on or after 25th April 2022 for up to 22 days or until the works have been completed.

The roads will be closed at their junctions with each other.

The alternative route for both roads is via Redoubt Way, Uden Road, Beverley Gardens and vice versa.

NORTH ELHAM HILL, ELHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow drainage cleansing works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of North Elham Hill, Elham, on or after 13th May 2022 for up to 1 day, between 09:30 hours and 15:00 hours, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions of Canterbury Road and Holly Hill, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any Eastbound traffic is via High Street, St Marys Road, The Square, Duck Street, Running Hill, Standard Hill Top, Green Lane, and North Elham Hill.

The alternative route for any Westbound traffic is via North Elham Hill, Green Lane, Standard Hill Top, Running Hill, Duck Street, The Square, Pound Lane, Vicarage Lane, New Road, and High Street.

ROLFE LANE, NEW ROMNEY (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow sewer repair works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Rolfe Lane, New Romney, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 89 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between number 107 and Mayfair, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Rolfe Lane, Cockreed Lane, Ashford Road, and vice versa.

BATTS ROAD JUNCTION OF GOLD STREET TO JUNCTION WITH HENLEY STREET, COBHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Openreach works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Batts Road Junction Of Gold Street To Junction With Henley Street, Cobham, on or after 10th May 2022 for up to 1 day between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Henley Street and Batts Road.

The alternative route is via Batts Road Junction Of Gold Street To Junction With Henley Street, Gold Street, Henley Street and vice versa.

LOWER ROAD, HIGHAM. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of UKPN works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Lower Road, Higham, on or after 29th April 2022 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside The Hedgerows.

The alternative route is via Lower Road, Green Farm Lane, A226 Gravesend Road, Forge Lane, School Lane, Chalk Road and vice versa.

PIER ROAD, NORTHFLEET (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Southern Water works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Pier Road, Northfleet, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 81.

The alternative route is via Pier Road, Lansdowne Square, Burch Road, Cross Road and vice versa.

PRINCES STREET, GRAVESEND. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPEND ONE-WAY) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of the re-setting of carriageway bricks, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Princes Street, Gravesend, on or after 29th April 2022 for up to 1 night between 19.00hrs and 01.00hrs or until the works have been completed. The One-Way will be suspended to allow access.

The road will be closed between Church Street and New Road.
