

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

The road will be closed between Mussenden Farm House and The Barn.

The alternative route is via Mussenden Lane, Three Gates Road, Scratchers Lane, A20 Gorse Hill, Eglantine Lane and vice versa.

PARK LANE, SEVENOAKS. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of a new sewer connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Park Lane, Sevenoaks, on or after 25th April 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 10.

The alternative route is via Park Lane, Holly Bush Lane, Avenue Road, Vine Court Road and vice versa.

POUNDSBRIDGE LANE, PENSHURST. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of drainage works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Poundsbridge Lane, Penshurst, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Poundsbridge Lane and Bullingstone Lane.

The alternative route is via Poundsbridge Lane, B2176 Penshurst Road, Barden Road, Northfields and vice versa.

RECTORY LANE, BRASTED. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of drainage works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Rectory Lane, Brasted, on or after 10th May 2022 for up to 16 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between A25 High Street and number 8.

The alternative route is via A25 High Street, Church Road, Coles Lane, Rectory Lane and vice versa.

SOUTH BROOK LANE, TOYS HILL. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of drainage CCTV works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of South Brook Lane, Toys Hill, on or after 29th April 2022 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the vicinity of Brook Cottage.

The alternative route is via Green Lane, Toys Hill and vice versa.

SPRINGCROFT, HARTLEY. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of carriageway repairs, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Springcroft, Hartley, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed for the entire length.

There is no alternative route but access will be given as and when safe to do so.

SUNDRIDGE HILL, SUNDRIDGE. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of Openreach works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Sundridge Hill, Sundridge, on or after 10th May 2022 for up to 1 day between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed for the entire length.

The alternative route is via Sundridge Hill, Pilgrims Way, Brasted Hill, Brasted Lane, Main Road and vice versa.

WATERY LANE, KEMSING. (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

Because of drainage works, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Watery Lane, Kemsing, on or after 11th May 2022 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between Heaverham Road and The Old Byre.

The alternative route is via Watery Lane, Honey Pot Lane, Noahs Ark, St Ediths Road, High Street, Heaverham Road and vice versa.

SWALE AREA

A2 OSPRINGE STREET, FAVERSHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2022

To allow carriageway repair works to be carried out Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of A2 Ospringe Street, Faversham, on or after 25th April 2022 for up to 4 nights between the hours of 20:00 and 05:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from the junction with Water

Lane to outside King George V Playing Fields, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

It will also be necessary to impose a no-waiting restriction from the junction with Water Lane to outside King George V Playing Fields, to the extent indicated clearly on site.

The alternative route is via A2 London Road, Canterbury Road, Love Lane, Whitstable Road, East Street, Crescent Road, Court Street, Quay Lane, Conduit Street, North Lane, South Road, Napleton Road, Tanners Street, Curtis Way, Dark Hill, Bysing Wood Road and Western Link.

ALEXANDRA ROAD, SHEERNESS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY) TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2022

To allow electrical connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Alexandra Road, Sheerness, on or after 12th May 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from outside number 22 to outside number 32, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

It will also be necessary to temporarily suspend the following one-way Orders, to allow for diverted traffic.

- Alexandra Road, Sheerness - between the junctions with Clyde Street and Marine Parade.
- Clyde Street - between the junctions with Alexandra Street and Richmond Street.

The alternative route is via Clyde Street, Richmond Street, Marine Parade and vice versa.

BRENT HILL, FAVERSHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2022

To allow clearance works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Brent Hill, Faversham, on or after 11th May 2022 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Flood Lane and Davington Hill, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Brent Road, Church Road, Bramblehill Road, Reedland Crescent, Barnfield Road, Priory Row and Davington Hill.

CAMBRIDGE ROAD & SCHOOL ROAD, FAVERSHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2022

To allow vegetation works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Cambridge Road & School Road, Faversham, on or after 28th April 2022 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:00 and 14:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with B2040 Ospringe Road and Kings Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Ospringe Road, South Road, Nightingale Road, Kings Road and vice versa.

FRINSTED ROAD, MILSTEAD & MILSTEAD, FRINSTED (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2022

To allow pole testing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Frinsted Road, Milstead, on or after 28th April 2022 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The roads will be closed between the junctions with Manor Road and Torry Hill, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Torry Hill, Manor Road and vice versa.

MAPLE STREET, SHEERNESS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2022

To allow connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Maple Street, Sheerness, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 56A, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Maple Street, Vincent Gardens, High Street and vice versa.

MARINE PARADE, SHEERNESS (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2022

To allow replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Marine Parade, Sheerness, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 9, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for traffic travelling eastbound

is via Broadway, Trinity Road, Cavour Road, Invicta Road, High Street, Halfway Road, Minster Road, The Broadway, Marine Parade.

The alternative route for traffic travelling westbound is via Marine Parade, The Broadway, Minster Road, Halfway Road, High Street, Millenium Way, Trinity Road and Broadway.

STAPLESTREET ROAD, HERNE HILL (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2022

To allow drainage maintenance works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Staplestreet Road, Hernhill, on or after 26th April 2022 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from the junction with Bound Lane to outside Mount Ephraim B&B, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Staplestreet Road, The Street, Bull Lane, Butts Hill, Staple Street and vice versa.

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, BOROUGH OF SWALE) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO.38) ORDER 2022

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL intends to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 3 (2), 4 (1) and (2), 32 (1), 35 (1), 44, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby propose to make the following order:-

The effect of the proposed named Order will be to install waiting restrictions in the following lengths of road (in this part of the notice DYL's means double yellow lines) waiting to be prohibited at any time.

Roads in Sittingbourne in the Borough of Swale

CHURCH ROAD - DYL - (1) On the east side from the junction with Tonge Road extend the existing lines outside 10 Church Road by 4.5 metres in a northerly direction. (2) On the west side opposite the junction with Tonge Road extend the existing lines opposite 10 Church Road by 21.1 metres in a northerly direction.

TONGE ROAD - DYL - (1) On the north side reduce the existing lines outside 110 Tonge Road by 3 metres in an easterly direction. (2) On the north side from the junction with Portland Road reduce the existing lines outside 52 Tonge Road by 3 metres in a westerly direction. (3) On the north side extend the existing lines from the junction with Church Road by 5.6 metres in an easterly direction to join up with the school keep clear markings. (4) On the south side to extend the existing lines from the junction with Wykeham Road outside 5 Tonge Road by 4.5 metres in an easterly direction. (5) On the south side place new lines from the boundary of 113/115 Tonge Road for a distance of 21.4 metres in an easterly direction.

TONBRIDGE & MALLING AREA

BARDEN ROAD, TONBRIDGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2022

To allow maintenance works to be carried out on apparatus, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Barden Road, Tonbridge, on or after 25th April 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Norfolk Road and Preston Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

There is no alternative route for this closure. However, residential access will be maintained at all times, when it is safe to do so.

BARDEN PARK ROAD, TONBRIDGE (PROHIBITION OF

DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2022

To allow rail maintenance and other associated works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Barden Park Road, Tonbridge, on or after 8th May 2022 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of the level crossing, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

There is no alternative route for this closure. However, residential access will be maintained on site, when it is safe to do so.

BRACKEN WALK, TONBRIDGE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2022

To allow ducting works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Bracken Walk, Tonbridge, on or after 27th April 2022 for up to 3 days between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 14, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Greenfrith Drive, Beechmont Rise, Bishops Oak Ride, Bracken Walk and vice versa.

COMMON ROAD, IGHTHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2022

To allow overhead structure works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Common Road, Ightham, on or after 25th April 2022 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Copt Hall Road and Sandy Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Sandy Lane, Coach Road, Copt Hall Road and vice versa.

COMP LANE, OFFHAM (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2022

To allow pole testing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Comp Lane, Offham, on or after 26th April 2022 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions with Teston Road and Bramble Hill Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Comp Lane, B2016 Seven Mile Lane, Teston Road and vice versa.

CROUCH LANE, BOROUGH GREEN (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2022

To allow overhead cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Crouch Lane, Borough Green, on or after 10th May 2022 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed from the junction with Maidstone Road to outside number 1 Tillmans, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Maidstone Road, Long Mill Lane, Crouch Lane and vice versa.

CYCLE TRACK FROM CHATHAM ROAD TO KITS COTY SLIP, NORTHBOUND, AYLESFORD. (PROHIBITION OF CYCLISTS) TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2022

To allow drainage cleansing works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order prohibiting through cyclists on part of Cycle Track From Chatham Road To Kits Coty Slip Northbound, Aylesford, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 1 day or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed adjacent to the Shell Garage to the junction with Old Chatham Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

There is no alternative route for this closure.

FORD LANE, TROTTSICLIFFE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2022

To allow electrical connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order prohibiting through traffic on part of Ford Lane, Trottsicliffe, on or after 25th April 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of Mount Mead, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Ford Lane, London Road, Trottsicliffe Road, Mill House Lane, Addington Lane and vice versa.
