As shown between the points A and B on the Order plan and to provide a new length of public A new length of public footpath numbered AE349 with a width of 2.5 metres, which commences at the aforementioned Point A at NGR TR 0372 3991 and runs in a generally south-southwest direction for approximately 12 metres to NGR TR 0371 3990 (Point C) before heading in a generally west-northwest direction for approximately 85 metres to its connection with Cheeseman's Green Lane at NGR TR 0363 3993 (Point D), as shown between points A, C and D on the Order plan.

The effect of the Order, as confirmed, is to divert the entire width of that length of Public Footpath numbered AW306A which commences at NGR TR 0202 3904 (Point A) and runs in an east southeasterly direction for 215 metres to NGR TR 0223 3901 (Point B) then continues in a northeasterly direction for 119 metres to NGR TR 0232 3909 (Point C), then continues in a southeasterly direction for 48 metres to NGR TR 0236 3906 (Point D), then continues in a northeasterly direction for 60 metres to a termination point on Public Footpath AE390B at NGR TR 0239 3911 (Point E). The effect of that Order, as confirmed, is to divert the entire width of that length of public bridleway numbered HE181, which commences on Swanton Lane at NGR TR 2307 4402 (point A) and runs south south-east through to south for 640 metres to NGR TR 2332 4345 (point B) where it is obstructed by the churchyard wall. It continues to run south to a point on the unaffected length of bridleway numbered HE181 just south of the churchyard at NGR TR 2332 4342 (point C). Between the points A-B-C on the Order plan. The Order will provide a new length of public bridleway numbered HE181, which commences at the aforementioned point C and runs north-east for 16 metres and then turns to run north-west for 615 metres to its connection with Swanton Lane at NGR TR 2301 4396 (point D), 96 metres south-west of the aforementioned point A. Between the points C-B-E-D on the Order plan. The new length of bridleway will have a width of 3 metres, except for a pinch point of 2.0 metres where it passes through a gap in the hedge line at NGR TR 2322 4362 (point E).
