

# Highways

Kent County Council, acting in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, makes or intends to make the following Orders.

## THANET AREA

### A28 CANTERBURY ROAD, SARRE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow cat's eye and lining replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of the A28 Canterbury Road, Sarre, on or after 23rd May 2022 for up to 3 nights, between 20:00 hours and 05:00 hours, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions of the A299 St Nicholas Roundabout and A253 Ramsgate Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via A253 Ramsgate Road, A253 Canterbury Road, A299 Monkton Roundabout, A299 Thanet Way, and vice versa.

### A28 MARINE TERRACE, MARGATE (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022 THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994 SECTION 16A

For the safety of the public whilst an event is being held on the highway Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit the use of vehicles on:-

A28 Marine Terrace, Margate, between 09:30 hours and 14:30 hours from the 23rd May 2022, with completion by the 27th May 2022.

The alternative route for any westbound traffic is via A254 Belgrave Road, A254 Eaton Road, A255 Grosvenor Gardens, A255 High Street, A255 St Peters Road, B2052 College Road, B2052 Hartsdown Road, B2052 George V Avenue, and A28 Canterbury Road.

The alternative route for any eastbound traffic is via A28 Canterbury Road, B2052 George V Avenue, B2052 Hartsdown Road, Tivoli Road, Beatrice Road, B2052 College Road, A255 St Peters Road, A255 Ramsgate Road, A254 Queens Avenue, A254 Eaton Road, and A254 Belgrave Road.

### A254 RAMSGATE ROAD, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow new pathway installation works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to enforce a 30 MPH speed limit on A254 Ramsgate Road, Margate, between the junctions of Farley Road and Nash Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

This restriction will be in place on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 23 days, between 08:00 hours and 17:00 hours, or until the works have been completed.

### B2050 MANSTON ROAD, BIRCHINGTON (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow sign replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily impose a 30 MPH speed limit on part of the B2050 Manston Road, Birchington, between the junctions of Shottendane Road and Acol Hill, to the extent indicated by signs on site.

The restriction will be in place on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 1 day, or until the works have been completed.

### COTTINGTON ROAD, CLIFFSEND (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow carriageway blockage clearance works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Cotington Road, Cliffsend, on or after 10th May 2022 for up to 3 days, between 09:30 hours and 15:30 hours, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed between the junctions of Old Hall Road and Oakland Court, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Cotington Road, Cotington Link, A299 Sevenscore Roundabout, A299 Hengist Way, Sandwich Road, Cliffs End Road, Foads Lane, and vice versa.

### DUNDONALD ROAD, RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Dundonald Road, Ramsgate, on or after 11th May 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 23, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Dundonald Road, Grange Road, Crescent Road, and vice versa.

### GORDON ROAD, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Gordon Road, Margate, on or after 11th May 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works

have been completed.

The road will be closed between numbers 50 and 54, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Gordon Road, A254 Ramsgate Road, Star Lane, and vice versa.

### HIGH STREET, RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPEND ONE-WAY) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of High Street, Ramsgate, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed. The one-way order will be suspended to allow access.

The road will be closed between numbers 42 and 48, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The road will be open for pedestrian access.

The alternative route is via High Street, King Street, Broad Street, and Church Hill.

### HOLLY LANE, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow carriageway reinstatement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Holly Lane, Margate, on or after 12th May 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 2, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Holly Lane, Northdown Road, Foreland Avenue, and vice versa.

### NASH COURT ROAD, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Nash Court Road, Margate, on or after 26th May 2022 for up to 1 night between 19:00 hours and 05:00 hours, or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 16, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Nash Court Road, A254 Ramsgate Road, Nash Lane, and vice versa.

### PRINCES STREET, MARGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPEND ONE-WAY) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow new water connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Princes Street, Margate, on or after 23rd May 2022 for up to 5 days or until the works have been completed. The one-way Order will be suspended to allow access.

The road will be closed from its junction with Addington Street for a distance approximately 50 metres in a Westerly direction, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Princes Street, B2055 Cecil Street, Hawley Square, and Addington Street.

### QUEENS ROAD AND BROCKENHURST ROAD, RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council intends to make an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Queens Road and Brockenhurst Road, Ramsgate, on or after 23rd May 2022 for up to 3 days, between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours, or until the works have been completed.

The roads will be closed between number 34 Queens Road and number 11 Brockenhurst Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Brockenhurst Road, Victoria Parade, Lyndhurst Road, Queens Road, and vice versa.

### UPPER DUMPTON PARK ROAD, RAMSGATE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Upper Dumpton Park Road, Ramsgate, on or after 9th May 2022 for up to 3 days or until the works have been completed.

The road will be closed outside number 32, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Upper Dumpton Park Road, A255 Boundary Road, Denmark Road, St Lukes Avenue, and vice versa.
